1. Clamp the fixture bracket to the helmet




2. Install the device into fixture bracket




2.2 Face Plate replacement Instructions

Insert the Steel Needle into the opening to remove the face plate , Apply tape to the Another Face Plate , Align the position and press firmly




2.3 Half Face Helmet


1. Apply 3M tape to the inside of the helmet, align position to the ear. Stick the headphone to position




2. Attach the 3M tape to the left side of the helmet and fix the microphone



3. Confirm the location of the microphone - keep it 1-2 cm from your mouth






2.4 Full Face Helmet


