Introduction to TV box Functions

Support gesture control, voice control, and mobile phone remote control for on-trend smart living. Support video calls, magic cameras, and motion sensing games for hands-down life and entertainment.



Attention

- Please don't put parts in your mouth, especially small ones;
- Do not plug in and out with wet hands;
- Power off and disconnect reminder;
- Keep a minimum of 0.39in clearance around the device and do not cover with items such as newspapers;
- No water droplets or splashes, and liquid-filled items such as vases are not allowed on the device;
- Keep the product away from dust, moisture, ravage, high temperature, etc., and away from magnetic objects;
- Do not scratch the housing and interface, and prevent product damage from heavy pressure, falling, throwing or strong impact;

Troubleshooting

No display after power on?
Confirm your device is connected to the TV well and set the correct HDMI Input from your TV configuration.

TV has images but no sound?
Make sure your TV is not in mute and low volume.

Fail to connect to the network?
Make sure the Ethernet cable is properly connected. Make sure Wi-Fi is functional and your box has a strong enough signal from your router.

Remote control failure?
Replace the battery of the remote control with a new one, and make sure it is placed in the correct polarity. Make sure the remote control is within the range of the TV box. Go to the Setting menu to unpair and re-pair the remote control.

How to deal with the video lag?
Try to switch to Hardware Decoding or System Decoding.
