



# Bluetooth headset

## Use charging

1.Charge the TWS: put the speaker's ear into the charging chamber, close the cover, the charging chamber will light up red, and it will automatically enter the charging state  
2.Charging the case: when charging, the red indicator light of the charging case flashes. The red indicator is always on after the charging is completed.

## Check power

earphone power: After the earphone is connected to the phone, you can check the earphone power in the phone status bar.

The case power: Put the earphone into the charging case, and when the charging case is closed, the red indicator light of the charging case is always on for about 10 seconds, indicating that the battery is sufficient.

The red indicator light of the charging case flashes or does not light up, and the green light is displayed when the cover is opened, indicating that the battery is low and needs to be charged in time.

## Connect the new device

Turn on the earphone and wait for connection.  
Turn on the device Bluetooth, search and connect the earphone Bluetooth name (LF162)

## Connection interrupted

When the device turns off Bluetooth or the earphone connection range is exceeded, the earphone will automatically enter the status of waiting for connection. If no device is connected within 5 minutes, the earphone will automatically turn off.

## Product Operating Instructions

Power on: open the charging case, the earphone will power on automatically, long press the earphone touch key for 2S, and power on manually. Power off: put the earphone back into the charging case, close the charging case, and the earphone will automatically disconnect and enter the sleep state. Press and hold the earphone touch key for 5s to manually turn off the earphone.

Volume increase or decrease: three clicks on the right side

means increase, and three clicks on the left side means decrease

Up and down music: Double click the left for the previous music, double click the right for the next music

Play/pause : 1 Click

Answer the call: click when calling

Reject call: press for two seconds

SIRI function: press for 2 seconds and beep

Earphone pairing: automatic pairing of earphone out of case.
