1. Please comply with the following before using the product:

- Clean the product completely: Scrub it with an antibacterial soap and then wash with clean hot warm water; at last, wipe it gently with towel or soft cloth.

2. During using the product

- No using massage oil or hand cream as lubricant.
- No using silicon-based lubricant, because it'll damage the organosilicone surface.

Reminder: Do not use any cleaning agent containing alcohol, gasoline or acetone to wipe the product. Avoid direct solar radiation and long-time exposure to the high-temperature environment. The product shall be stored in a clean and dry place without contact with other plastic products.

Maintenance of the Built-in Battery:

- This product uses rechargeable batteries. A new battery could play its full effectiveness after two or three charging and discharging processes.
- A battery can be charged or discharged for over 100 times and will go matured finally. After being charged fully, the battery shall be disconnected with the charger, or overcharge may reduce the battery life.
- When the product is idle, the electric quantity of fully charged battery will lose gradually.
- If the product is placed in a too hot or cold place, it will reduce the battery capacity and shorten the battery life. If the battery is too hot or cold, the battery life will be also short even though it is charged fully.

Battery Warning!


- When the battery is operated by mistake, it will fire or cause chemical burn. Explosion may happen when the battery is damaged.

Operation Instructions


Step 1

1. For the first use, long press " " and release it after the second vibration to enter the "calibration mode".




Step 2

1. Two devices: long press " " for 1 second, and the red work indicator lights up.
2. Power on will enter "PressureSensorer Mode" by default.




Step 3


1. As shown in the figure, hold the control end of the wand.
2. The equipment will increase or decrease the vibration intensity of the equipment according to the pressure intensity.
3. At this point, the new function has been unlocked, allowing you to play for a while, remember to come back and unlock more ways to play.



Step 4

1. Click the button " " on the scepter, two devices will vibrate and enter the "offline mode".
2. Click the " " to adjust the vibration intensity under the "offline mode" and two devices can be used individually.
3. Click the " " on the scepter again to the "PressureSensorer Mode".
4. Press the two " " to turn off the device.





Product description

Online mode

1. Click " " 1s to start the two devices and enter the "PressureSensorer Mode"

Offline mode

Vibrator

1. Click" " to switch gears (1-2-3)
2. Click" "1s to shut down

Wand:

1. Click " " to switch to "offline mode"
2. Click to switch to "PressureSensorer Mode"

Calibration mode

Wand:

1. Click" " 5s to release after twice vibration and enter "calibration mode"
