- Failure to follow these directions may void the warranty


Getting Started

Make sure you read this guide, before using the Keyboard. Reading this guide will help you learn how to use the Keyboard properly. Store this guide safely so that you can use it in the future.




WIRELESS KEYBOARD LAYOUT

CONNECTION INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions:

1. Connect your Bluetooth keyboard to your PS5 wireless controller via the controller 3.5mm jack.
2. Turn on your PS5 console and DualSense controller.
3. Turn on the keyboard with the on/off switch - the blue indicator will light up.
4. Press and hold the 'Pairing key' for 3 seconds to begin pairing the device. The indicator will flash until pairing is complete
5. On your PlayStation 5 console, navigate to 'Settings' > 'Devices' > 'Bluetooth Device'
6. Find the device named 'SURGE Bluetooth Keyboard' and select to pair
7. Enter the passkey displayed by your console and then press the 'enter key' to pair with your controller

OTHER FUNCTIONS

1. To type the symbols in blue, press and hold the 'function key'  and the corresponding symbol key.
2. To type capital letters, press the 'Caps lock key'  once and then the letter. Pressing the 'Caps lock key'  again will cancel this function.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

1. If the indicator light flashes blue twice it means the keyboard needs to be charged. Connect the included USB-C charge cable to charge the device - the indicator turns red when charging and turns off once fully charged.
2. The Bluetooth pairing mode will stay active for 3 minutes.
3. When the Bluetooth connection is lost the keyboard will go into sleep mode. To wake the device, simply press any key with the device inside the effective Bluetooth range.
4. The keyboard should pair automatically with the PS5 console after the initial pairing. If the re-connection fails, please follow the connection instructions to pair again.
5. In the PS5 console settings (Setting → Device → Audio Devices → Input Device → Headset Connected to Controller), you can adjust the volume and microphone levels once the keyboard has been inserted into the PS5 controller via the 3.5mm jack. This is only applicable if a headset with microphone function is connected to the 3.5mm audio output
