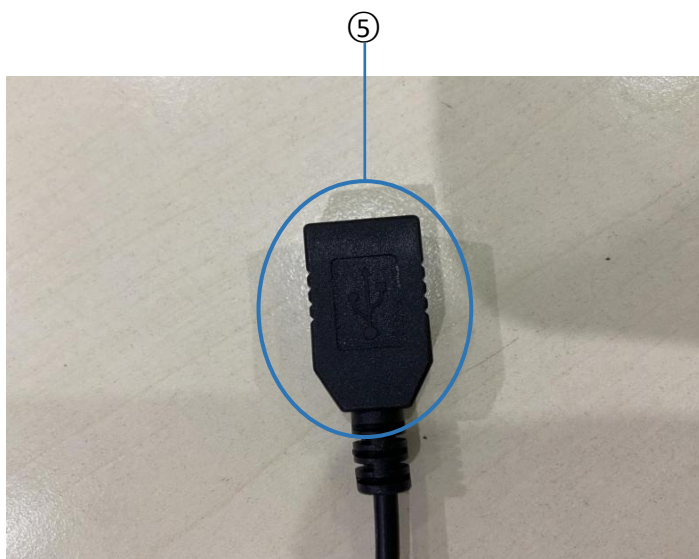
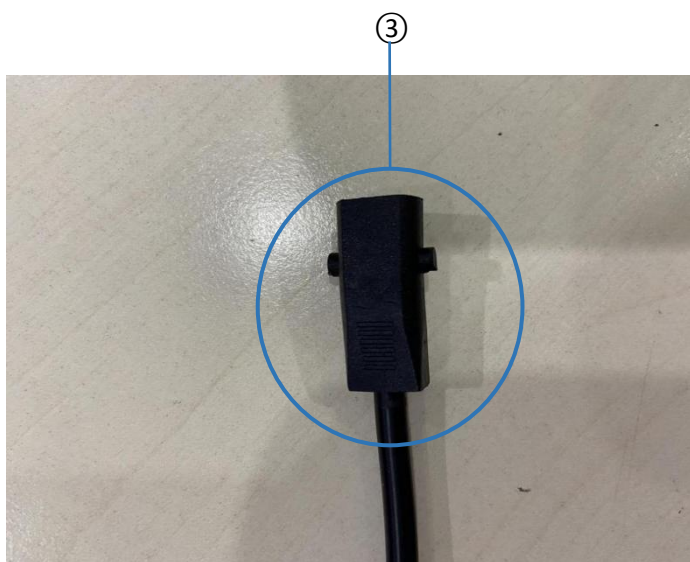
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③ Zero-line female header, output voltage 29V

5. Warning

- 1) Metal objects cannot be placed on wireless charging
- 2) No heavy objects can be placed on the wireless charging
- 3) The mobile phone without wireless charging cannot be charged at the charging place
