




Do not open the cabinet

Do not touch the power cable with wet hands




Insert the plug in the socket firmly




Switch off a player if the contacts of the cable plug/wire are not completely in a socket of power point

If it is very cold, please turn on the power for 1min. Then turn off the power for 1 min. Then you can turn on and use the unit




Do not expose the unit to the direct sunlight or in abnormal hot place




Do not situate this unit in the moist place


Notes about discs

Disc handling precautions


- To keep the disc clean, handle the disc by its edge. Do not touch the surface.
- Do not stick paper or tape on the disc. If there is glue (or a similar substance) on the disc, remove the glue completely before using the disc.
- Do not expose the disc to direct sunlight or sources such as hot air ducts, or leave it in a car parked in direct sunlight as there can be considerable rise in temperature inside the car.
- After playing, store the disc in its case.
- Do not write on the label side with a ball-point pen or other writing utensils.
- Be careful not to drop or bend the disc.

Disc cleaning precautions

- Before playing, clean the disc with a cleaning cloth. Wipe the disc from the center out.
- Do not use solvents such as benzine, thinner, commercially available cleaners or anti-static spray intended for vinyl LPs.
- Disc installing precautions
 - Do not install more than 1 disc on disc tray.
 - Do not place the disc on the tray up-side down.
 - Do not try to close the disc tray when the disc is not installed properly.



Front panel



Max. 32GB memory size of USB device can be supported.

Unless stated otherwise, the remote control can operate all the features of the VIDEO Player, always point the remote control directly at the remote sensor on the front of the VIDEO Player, not the TV

FM Function

1. Press "FUN" and then choose FM mode.
2. Press "SCAN" on remote controller to search FM radio stations automatically.
3. Press "PREV/CH-" "NEXT/CH+" for previous/next FM station

AUX INPUT Description


The CD support Mp3, MP4, CD etc which lower than 2V make sound bigger by AUX L/R input. Press "FUN" key on the remote control or on the front panel to change into AUX IN mode, and also can press Volume +, - to control the sound.

Connect via Bluetooth

1. Press FUNCTION button to select BLUETOOTH mode.
2. To pair with smartphone, turn on Bluetooth in your mobile phone and search for devices.
3. Select the device named IQ-9000BT.
4. You can hear a little sound coming from the unit after successfully pairing via Bluetooth.
5. Now you can play music in your mobile phone



Connecting to Speaker



Connect the supplied speakers with the supplied speaker wires matching the LETTER (L/R) of the jacks and corresponding speaker.

Examples of poor conditions of the speaker cord

- Stripped speaker cord is touching another speaker terminal.
- Stripped cords are touching each other due to excessive removal of insulation.



Connecting FM aerial

Connect the supplied FM aerial to the FM jack
Move the aerial in various directions until the
Clearest signal is received.

Note:

Keep the aerial as far away as possible from the
TV, VCR or any radiation sources to prevent
unwanted noise.
