

USER MANUAL

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

The SkyMind MR 900 Gateway needs to be mounted on a fixed surface (e.g. a wall, a pillar) using appropriate fixings. It should be protected from the elements, like snow, rain and direct sunlight.

For optimal range, the SkyMind MR 900 Gateway should to be mounted 2m to 5m above ground in a place within range of a 3G or 4G mobile network.

For more information and mounting instructions, please refer to the Installation Manual (Appendix A).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

STORAGE OF GATEWAY

When not in use, store in clean conditions at room temperature.

FIRST USE

Once the SkyMind MR 900 Gateway is plugged in, the Gateway will automatically turn on and start its boot-up cycle and connect to the internet via the built-in 3G / 4G technology. Once this is completed, both the green and the blue LEDs will turn on.

To connect the SkyMind MR 900 Gateway to the SkyMind Cloud, follow the instructions in the Installation Manual (Appendix A).

REGULAR USE

The SkyMind MR 900 Gateway needs to be connected to a stable power outlet to work. It will automatically forward received LoRa signals from SkyMind Loggers to the SkyMind Cloud.

There is no further user interface or required user interaction.

STATUS DISPLAY (LEDS)

The Gateway has three LEDs on the bottom of the case, providing information about the state of the Gateway.

Blue, steady light	The Gateway is connected to the internet via the built-in GSM technology	
Green, steady light	The Gateway is connected to a power supply and is turned on	
Red, steady light There is an error with the Gateway and/or the internet connection		

When plugging in the Gateway, all three LEDs will light up to verify their functionality. After the bootup cycle (can take a few minutes), both the blue and the green LED should be on.

Should this not be the case, or should the red LED be on, contact SkyMind Support.

POWER OUTLET ADAPTER

Gateway comes equipped with a power outlet adapter for locations where one may be needed. Ensure that the power outlet is correctly connected to the adapter before plugging it into the socket.



TROUBLESHOOTING

Common problems.

Problem	Possible solution
No Power	Power problems are often caused by a malfunction of the power outlet being used.
	 Plug in any other device to ensure the power outlet is working. Try to connect the Gateway to a different working power outlet.
No Connection	Reboot the device often solve connection problems. 1. Make sure you have a stable 3G and/or 4G connection at the installation location.
	Reboot the Gateway by unplugging, waiting 10 seconds, and plugging it back into the power outlet.

Step-By-Step Installation Manual

Users are solely responsible for ensuring the safety and security of the installation/mounting process of the Gateway, including but not limited to following proper procedures, utilizing appropriate tools, materials, and safeguarding against potential risks, with a commitment to preventing any compromise of system integrity or unauthorized access.





Objective

The purpose of this document is to explain and illustrate the correct installation procedure for the SkyMind Gateway. All SkyMind Gateways are fully pre-configured, plug & play, and ready for operation when delivered.



Description of installation 3

Power outlet adapter (if needed)

Select the right adapter for the power plug corresponding to your local power socket.



Find power outlet


Find the closest power outlet to the ULD area where the Gateway is going to be installed permanently. Make sure the power outlet has electricity.

If no power outlet is available

If you did not find a power outlet, please coordinate the installation of a new power outlet close to the ULD location.




Check cellular connectivity before installing a new power outlet in the location (see 3.3).



Check mobile network/cellular connectivity


Once you find the power outlet, you need to be sure you have cellular connectivity in the same location. Use your smartphone or tablet, disable 5G and check if you have 3G and/or 4G network available. The Gateway only works with 3G and 4G cellular connectivity, not 5G.



Check mounting possibilities

Assess mounting options 1 or 2 (see 3.6 and 3.7), making sure you can install the Gateway in a fixed and stable position close to the power outlet.

If you have a power outlet, 3G/4G connection, and a stable mounting possibility, you may proceed to the next point. Otherwise, contact our support team.



3.5 Gateway functionality test

Plug the Gateway to the power outlet, lights will start flickering on & off. After 15 minutes, the **green** and **blue** light should be on.

This means the Gateway is functional, the test is successful. After a successful test, unplug the Gateway and proceed with mounting.

- Blue Connected






3.6 Mounting option 1 (Preferred)

Required Material: Ladder, sticker template, drill, hammer, screwdriver, 2x wall plugs and 2x screws. The Gateway must be installed between 2 and 5 meters from the ground (6.5 and 16.5 ft) in a stable and fixed position.


3.6.1 Clean the wall and stick the drilling sticker template.





3.6.3 Remove the sticker.
Hammer the wall plugs in the holes.

3.6.4 Screw in the Gateway with the screwdriver. Plug in the power outlet.




3.7 Mounting option 2


Required Material: Ladder, cable ties, cutting pliers, steel straps. Two people are recommended for this mounting. The Gateway must be installed between 2 and 5 meters from the ground (6.5 and 16.5 ft) in a stable and fixed position.

NB: There are endless possibilites depending on where the Gateway will be installed, here are 2 examples.

3.7.1 Example A


Attaching to a metal net, truss or cable tray.






3.7.2 Example B

Attaching around a beam or pole. Make sure the length is correct and cut the steel strap accordingly.




With the steel straps, go through the two larger holes at the center of the two sides of the Gateway and screw* around the beam/pole.

Once the Gateway is properly mounted, use your smartphone/tablet to scan the QR-code on the Gateway or enter the URL manually on your browser to start the initialization process.

Then, follow the step-by-step process directly on the Web App*: *Actual process in the Web App may slightly differ





1. Enter your login credentials.

Scan the QR code on the Gateway.

3. Verify the Gateway number, select the location and area of installation.







5. Verify the summarized information.

Troubleshooting
