

Usage instructions

1. When the product does not respond, charge it first. When the power is insufficient, the device will automatically enter the shutdown state.
2. Boot matching: Long press the top button for 2 seconds to turn on the power, the blue indicator flashes quickly, the device automatically enters the matching state, turn on the Bluetooth of the mobile phone, the matching name is BT280, after the device is successfully connected, the blue indicator light will be always on.
3. Connect successfully to play music, if you want to pause playing, just press the top button.
4. When playing music, press the left eye button once to play the previous song, press the right eye button once to play the next song.
5. Adjust the volume: When playing music, long press the right eye key to increase the volume, and long press the left eye key to reduce the volume.
- 6 Turn Off: Hold down the top button for 3 seconds to turn off the device. After the prompt tone and blue indicator turn off, the device automatically turns off.
