



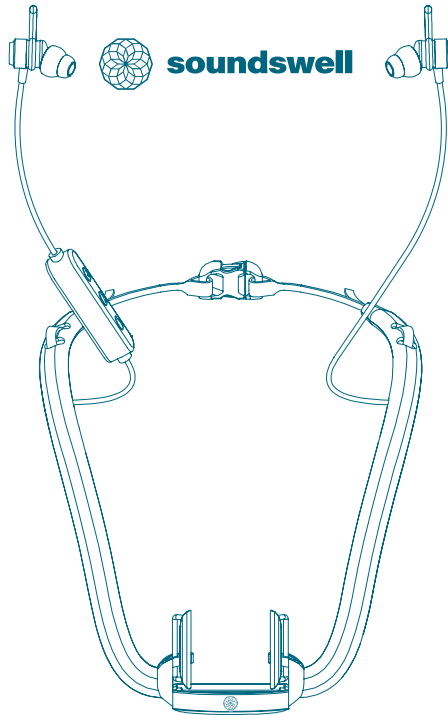

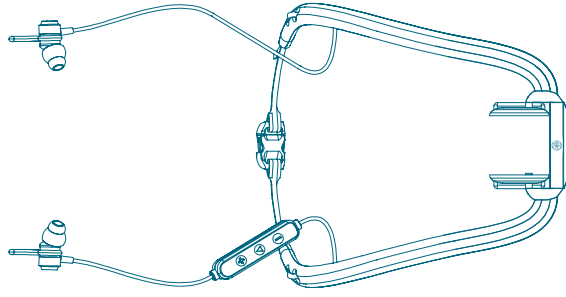

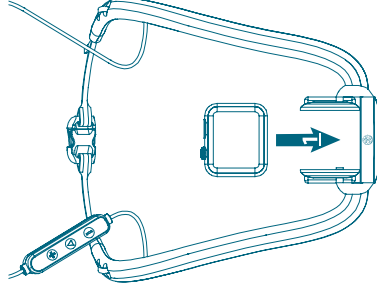
- 1 Click: Volume up

B) Play:

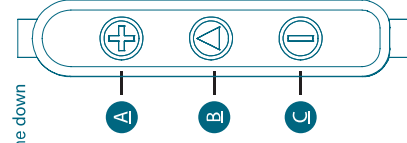
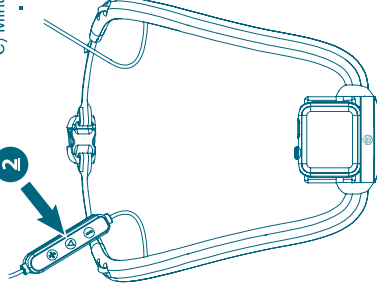
- 1 Click: Play/Pause
