

## INSTRUCTIONS

### 01/Safety tips

1.Do not put foreign metal objects in the charging area between the watch and wireless charger, which will lead to latent danger.

2.Do not put magnetic stripe cards (such as credit cards, telephone cards, bank cards, etc.) or some medical equipment (such as pacemakers or hearing aids) together with this product, which may cause damage to the magnetic stripe or abnormal operation of the equipment.

3.Do not apply heavy pressure ,and place it out of reach of children or animals.

### 02/Warranty
