

If the transmitter complies with the conducted power limits based on the use of RMS averaging over a time interval, as permitted under paragraph (b)(3) of this section, the attenuation required under this paragraph shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB. Attenuation below the general limits specified in §15.209(a) is not required. In addition, radiated emissions which fall in the restricted bands, as defined in §15.205(a), must also comply with the radiated emission limits specified in §15.209(a) (see §15.205(c)).







8.4.Test Procedure

- a. EUT was placed on a turn table, which is 0.8 meter high above ground for below 1GHz test, and which is 1.5 meter high above ground for above 1GHz test.
- b. EUT is set 3 meters away from the receiving antenna, which is mounted on a antenna tower.
- c. Set the EUT transmit continuously with maximum output power.
- d. The turn table can rotate 360 degrees to determine the position of the maximum emission level.
- e. The antenna can be moved up and down between 1 meter and 4 meters to find out the maximum emission level. Both horizontal and vertical polarization of the antenna are set on test.
- f. Spectrum analyzer setting parameters in accordance with section 8.3.
- g. Repeat above procedures until all channels were measured.
- h. Record the results in the test report.

Note:

- 1. For emissions above 1GHz, if peak level comply with average limit, then the average level is deemed to comply with average limit.
- 2. The frequency 2402MHz ,2440MHz and 2480MHz is fundamental frequency which no limit, the limit on plots is automatically generated by the software, it's not fundamental limit, we can't remove it.
- 3. BLE 1Mbps and BLE 2Mbps mode all have been tested, only worse case BLE 1Mbps mode is reported.




Radiated Band Edge
