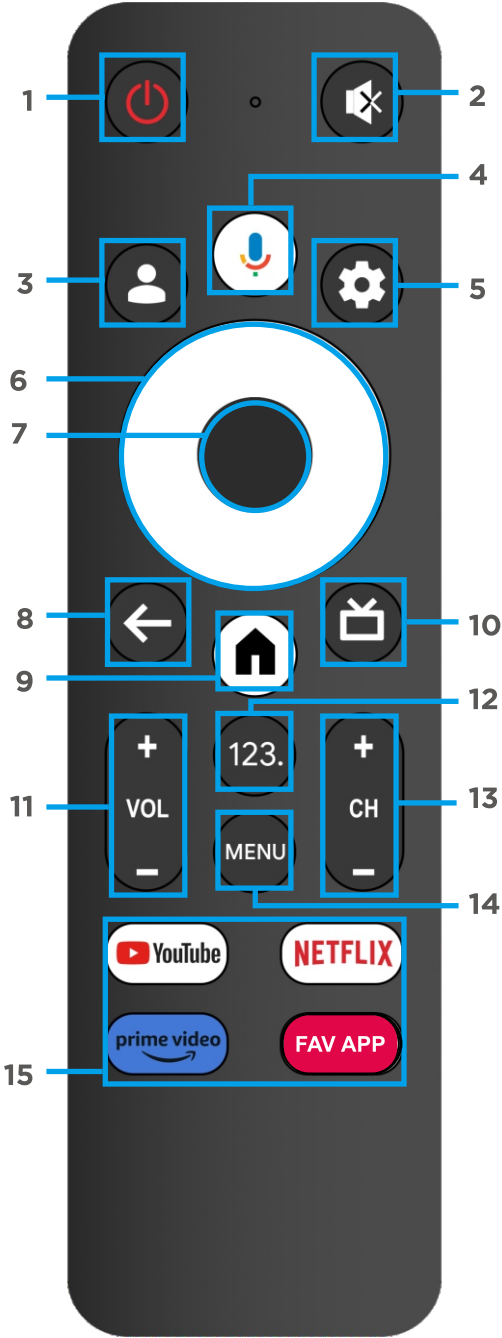

# REMOTE CONTROL

1. **POWER:** Turn the TV on/off.
2. **MUTE:** Turn the sound on or off.
3. **MEMBER:** Choose or add an account.
4.  : Start a voice search or speak to Google Assistant.
5. **SETTING:** Press to open the setting option.
6. **ARROWS:** Navigate on-screen menu.
7. **OK:** OK to confirm selection.
8. **BACK:** Return to previous menu.
9. **HOME:** Open Android TV home page.
10. **GUIDE:** Select electronic program guide, in DTV mode, it will display all the information of program in a week when pressing this button.
11. **VOLUME:** Increase or decrease TV volume.
12. **Keyboard:** Press to open the virtual keyboard
13. **CHANNEL:** Next or previous TV channel.
- INFO:** Display channel information.
14. **MENU:** Display Menu
15. **APPS:** Open Netflix, YouTube, PrimeVideo, **FAV APP**

Bluetooth pairing operation:

Long press the "home" and "back" buttons on the remote control, wait for the indicator light to start flashing, the remote control will display the Bluetooth name, and at the same time broadcast the Bluetooth pairing signal, and the remote control will enter pairing mode.
