

II. Instructions for use



Power/Play or pause/ hands-free call: Long press for power on /off. After turn on the speaker, go to your device setting and activate the Bluetooth® feature, then search for devices, Find this speaker which appears as "A27" on the device list and pair, The voice prompt will alert you if the pairing is successful. (If pass-code is requested, enter "0000.") In music: short press for play/pause: In calling: short press for answer /hang up phone call



Volume up/Next song: Long press for volume up, short press for next song.

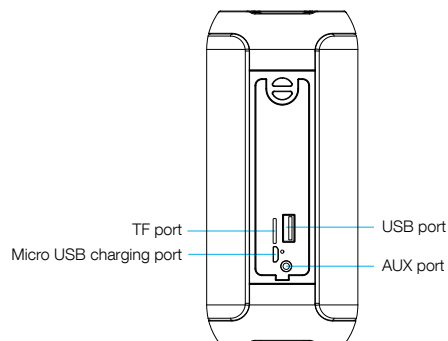
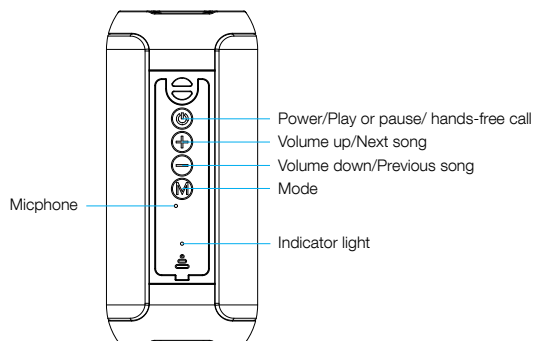


Volume down/Previous song: Long press for volume down, Short press for previous song.



Mode: Short press to switch between the bluetooth and FM mode .In FM mode, insert the Micro charging cable as antenna. Then long press the Play and Pause button to search the FM channel, Short press the Play and Pause button to settle the FM channel. And short press Volume up/Volume down to select the channel.
