Installation

Remove the battery cover of the Remote control, insert 2x1.5V AAA batteries (not included) inside the battery compartment, as per the indicated polarity. Put back the battery cover to secure.

Once the Bluetooth Speaker is paired with your device the music will transmit through the Bluetooth Speaker. Please refer to your device's user manual for further information.

Instruction For Use •



Control Functions

Increase Volume	Turn Voulme Knob or long press the Next Track button to adjust the volume to your desired level
Decrease Volume	Turn Voulme Knob or tlong press the Previous Track button to adjust the volume to your desired level
II Pause	Short press Play / Pause button once to pause music
► Play	Short press Play / Pause button once to resume music
← Previous track	Short press the Previous Track / Station button to the previous track
> Next track	Short press the Next Track / Station button to the next track

Listening to Music using USB / Micro SD (TF) Card Slot

Insert USB flash drive into the USB slot or Micro SD (TF) card into the Micro SD (TF) card slot accordingly. An indication tone would be heard, and music would play automatically.

(Note: USB / Micro SD (TF) Card: Supports up to 16GB; Supports music file format: MP3, WAV, APE. USB Flash Drive or Micro SD (TF) Card not included.)

Listening to Music using AUX-In

Plug the 3.5 mm Aux-in cable (included) into the AUX-In port of the speaker, voice message "Auxiliary mode" would be heard, and LED display will show. Plug the other end of the cable to the audio device (such as computer / tablet / MP3 Player etc.).

(Note: While using AUX-In function, except volume function, all functions such as playing next/previous track can be controlled only through your source device).

This equipment complies with FCC radiation exposure limits set forth for an uncontrolled environment. This equipment should be installed and operated with minimum distance 20cm between the radiator & your body.

Instruction For Use •



TWS pairing use (if you own 2 Bluetooth Speakers)

- · Make sure both speakers are "ON" and not paired with any Bluetooth device. An indication tone would be heard from each speaker.
- · Long press the TWS button on both units.
- · Both units will wirelessly connect with each other, and you would hear an indication tone after they pair together successfully. Display on one unit will show 'bLUE' without blinking, while the other will show 'bLUE'
- · Activate the Bluetooth function on your source device (Mobile Phone, Tablet etc). Please refer to manufacturer's instructions for instructions on enabling Bluetooth on your device.
- Search for available Bluetooth devices and you would find "TROPHY" Pair it with this device.
- You might be prompted with "Pair with TROPHY?" message on your source device, with "Cancel" and "OK" options. Please click "OK".
- If required, enter the password "0000" to pair with the device.
- · Once paired successfully, another indication tone would be heard.
- · You can now stream wireless music on your speaker through your source device.

Note: TWS stands for True Wireless. If you want to separate 2 speakers again for individual use, long press the TWS button on any one speaker.

Using the Wired Microphone

- Insert the plug of the Wired Microphones (not included) into the MIC PORT 1 or 2 of the speaker.
- Turn on the Microphone, and speak for megaphone operation or sing for Karaoke operation.

Using the Wireless Microphone

- Turn counter-clockwise the bottom part of the Wireless Microphone (included) to open the battery compartment, insert 2x1.5V AA batteries (not included) inside the battery compartment, as per the indicated polarity. Put back the bottom part and turn it clockwise to secure.
- Turn on the Wireless Microphone with green LED light, it will automatically connect with the speaker You can speak for megaphone operation or sing for Karaoke operation.

Note: Rotate the Mic volume knob to adjust your favorite volume level, and adjust your desire echo effect with the Microphone echo knob.

Color changing light mode (LEDs are not replaceable)

Short press the LED light mode button each time to change 6 different color changing LED light patterns (including off light mode).

Troubleshooting •

Symptom	Solution
Low sound level	Adjust source volume.Charge Battery.
No sound	Turn the VOLUME knob to increase the volume. Play the music in the connected device and make sure the volume level is in high level. Press the MODE button to set the input source to the desired function.
Sound distortion	Turn the VOLUME knob to decrease the volume
