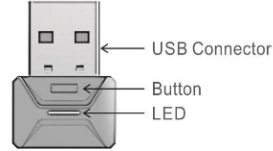


QUICK GUIDE

1. Open box and take out ATS-U1
2. Set Bluetooth headset, speaker or TWS earbuds to pairing mode, and keep it close to ATS-U1
3. Plug ATS-U1 into USB port of computer or gaming device, and LED start flashing quickly to enter pairing mode
4. Wait for LED A to turn constant on and ready to work



PRODUCT USER MANUAL

Function	User Action	LED Indication
Start up	Plug into USB port of PC or gaming device	LED flashing slowly
Pair with Bluetooth device	Press and hold button for 3 seconds	LED flashing quickly
Reconnect	Short press button	LED flashing slowly
Standby	-	LED off
Connected	-	LED on
Restore factory setting	Press and hold button for 8 seconds	LED flashing 3 times
