


# Remote Control Products User Manual



## < REMOTE CONTROL INSTRUCTION >

Power indicator  
Forward  
Circle backwards to the left  
Music

2x1.5V AAA

1. Open the battery cover.  
2. Install 2x1.5V AAA batteries(not included) in the correct positive (+) and negative (-) polarities direction.  
3. Close the battery cover.

Notice: If the remote control will not be used for a long time, please make sure to take out the batteries.

## < R/C CAR INSTRUCTION >

OFF/ON  
3x1.5V AA  
battery cover

1. Open the battery cover.
2. Install 3x1.5V AA batteries(not included) in the correct positive (+) and negative (-) polarities direction.
3. Close the battery cover.

Notice: If not used for a long time, please make sure to take out the batteries.

## < TROUBLE SHOOTING >

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
Motor does not run	1. Power switch is off please turn on. 2. Replace the battery.
Suddenly stopped during operation	1. Check if the battery is electrical. 2. Replace the battery.
Driving becomes slow	Replace the battery.
