CONTROLS

- 1. Power ON/OFF Button: Press+hold(3s): Power ON/OFF Press once: Pause/Play/Answer phone call. Press+hold 1s to reject phone call, 2x Press to call back the last call. Press once to start automatic search in FM mode.
- 2. Press once: Increase Volume : Press+hold (2s): Skip to the next track (or previous radio station in FM mode).
- 3. LED indicator: the blue light is on when the wireless is working, if the wireless is not connected, it blinks quickly, and if the wireless is connected, it blinks slowly. The red light is on when charging and off when fully charged.

4. Press once: Wireless /FM mode switch, Press+hold(2s) to connect TWS. Press+hold(2s) again to cancel TWS interconnection

5. Press once: Decrease Volume :

Charging port: Type C

- heard, now wireless speaker enters the wireless mode, LED indicator

GETTING STARTED

Charging the Wireless speaker

Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the charging port on the wireless speaker. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer or a compatible 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket

The LED indicator on the wireless speaker will turn RED while charging and turn off when fully charging.

Powering ON/OFF

Press and hold the ON/OFF button for 3 seconds to power the wireless speaker ON and OFF

When powered on, the wireless speaker may automatically reconnect to a nearby previously-paired device with wireless enabled.

Wireless Pairing

- 1. Press+hold the wireless speaker ON/OFF Button, "POWER ON" will be

In wireless mode, playback and volume can be adjusted by the controls on a connected device.

*Press once the Volume- and Volume+ buttons to Decrease Volume / Increase Volume.

*Press+hold 2s the Volume- and Volume+ buttons to skip to previous track / next track(next/previous Radio station in FM mode)
