


User Manual for Sound Clip Portable Speaker

### USING THE SOUND CLIP PORTABLE SPEAKER

	Volume Down	Short Press
	Previous Track	Long Press
	Flashlight On/Off SOS Mode Switch	Short Press

### PAIRING SPEAKER

1. Press and hold the power button (1) for 2-3 seconds to turn on the speaker.
2. The LED indicator will flash blue.
3. Turn on Bluetooth on your device (smartphone or tablet).
4. Select "HUMVEE PORTABLE SPEAKER" from the available device (smartphone or tablet).

### CHARGING SPEAKER

5. Turn off the speaker before charging.
6. Plug the USB-C cable into the speaker's charging port.
7. Plug the charging cable into a computer or connect the power adapter to a power outlet.
8. When charging, the LED indicator will glow solid red and will turn off automatically when fully charged.

#### NOTE:

Charge the speaker battery fully before its first use.

### TWS CONNECTION: Two Methods for Pairing Speakers

#### Method 1

- Turn on both speakers. Press the power button (1) of either speaker to activate the TWS connection (within 5 seconds). The LED light on the main speaker will flash blue, while the LED light on the second speaker will be off. The LED light will turn solid blue once the speaker is connected to the device.

#### Method 2

- Turn on one speaker and connect it to the device. Then, turn on the second speaker and double-press the power button (1) of either speaker to activate the TWS connection (within 5 seconds). The LED light on the first speaker will be solid blue, while the LED light on the second speaker will be off.
