- Ensure safe driving

2. Main Interface Function and Operation



1. Home key

Touch this key to return to the main interface;

2. Backlight mode icon

Touch the backlight mode icon to switch between day / night and turn off the backlight mode;

3. Radio mode icon

Touch the radio mode icon to enter the radio interface for operation;

4. Bluetooth profile Icon

Touch the Bluetooth mode icon to enter the Bluetooth interface for operation;

5. Time display

Display the current system time; Touch to switch clock format \ digital format display;

6. USB mode icon


Touch the USB mode icon to enter the USB interface for operation;

7. Set mode icon

Touch the setting mode icon to enter the setting mode for operation;

8. Display device connection status

Display the connection status of Bluetooth and USB. When it is connected, highlight the corresponding icon. When not connected, the corresponding icon is not displayed;



9. Phone link mode icon

Touch the phone link mode icon to enter the phone link interface for operation;

10. AUX mode icon

Tap the AUX mode icon to enter the AUX interface operation;

11. SD card mode icon

Touch the SD card mode icon to enter the SD card interface for operation;

12. wallpaper set

Tap the wallpaper icon to enter the wallpaper interface operation;


13. FCAM mode icon

Tap the FCAM mode icon to enter the FCAM interface operation;

14. RCAM mode icon

Tap the RCAM mode icon to enter the RCAM interface operation;

3. Radio Function Introduction and Operation



- 1. Touch this key to switch between remote \ short range;
- **2.**Touch this key to browse the stored radio stations, and long touch this key for 1s to search for stations from the lowest frequency point to the highest frequency point. And save the searched effective stations to the search list in turn, and the list is refreshed and replaced
- 3. Touch this key to cycle between FM > am > FM;
- 4. Touch this key to switch between stereo and mono;
- **5.**Touch this key to step the frequency point backward; Long touch 1s to search backward. After searching for a valid radio station, it will automatically stop it
- **6.**Station storage area, FM can store 18 stations; Am can store 12 radio stations;
- 7. Touch this key to step the frequency point forward; Long touch 1s to

search forward, and automatically search for a valid radio stationstop it;

6. Phone link function introduction and operation

Note: when using the mobile phone interconnection function, you need to select the connection mode of the vehicle end first;

Introduction to the function of phone link: Android wired mobile phones are interconnected. The mobile terminal needs to turn on USB debugging

in the developer's option; Android wireless mobile phone interconnection function interface, open the wireless screen projection function on the mobile terminal to search the deviceafter searching the device, click the device name to connect;

Apple Wireless mobile phones are interconnected. The mobile terminal needs to first connect to the WiFi of the car terminal, and then click the screen image function of the mobile terminal to search the device. After searching the device, click the device name to connect;

- 4. Touch this key to enter the wired car play function interface;




