

### OPERATIONS:

1. **Power Button** – Long press to turn on/off.
  - A. Turn speaker on – Long Press  
Boot Status: Defaults to Bluetooth mode. Open settings on your device – make sure Bluetooth is turned on. Open the Bluetooth menu, connect to device listed as "JFSPK". Speaker will say "dongdong" when paired. If the Bluetooth device was previously connected, it will automatically reconnect.
  - B. Short press: Play/Pause
  - C. Long Press: Turn off - Speaker will say "dongdong".
  - D. Speaker defaults to 50% Volume when turned on.
  - E. Volume will sync with phone
2. **(-) Button**
  - A. Long Press – Previous Song
  - B. Short Press – Reduce volume
3. **(+) Button**
  - A. Long Press – Next song
  - B. Short Press – Increase volume
4. **(\*) Button**
  - A. Short Press – Changes light mode - 8 modes. 9th press will turn lights off.
  - B. Long Press – Changes mode to White light only
5. **(/|) Button**
  - A. Short Press – Stops/Starts tentacles movement
6. **TF mode**: Insert TF card, automatically enter TF playback
7. **AUX mode**: Insert AUX and automatically enter AUX playback mode
8. **Low Power alarm**: Speaker will announce "dudu" several times before shutting off.
9. **Charging unit**: plug in charging cable & charge until Red LED indicator turns off.
