




Quick Start Guide

Model: DockPro

1.Functions & Operations



Power ON

Plug in the speaker and turn the switch to ON



3.5mm Aux-out Jack :

DockPro can't adapt to some digital audio speakers, if DockPro can't work on your speakers, you can use 3.5mm Aux cable to connect DockPro Aux-out jack to speaker Aux-in jack to play music. P.S.: If you use this connection method, you need to set some speakers to AUX-IN mode to work, as shown below



Bluetooth pairing

- * The blue light flashes in pairing mode;
- * Use the phone to search the Bluetooth name "DockPro" and get connected, the blue indicator light will always on.
- * Everytime you turn the device on, the DockPro will automatically connect to the last matching device.
- * Support up to 2 devices to connect to the DockPro at the same time.

Bluetooth pairing indicator

Status	Blue light
Waiting for pairing	Blink every 3 seconds
Paired successfully	Always on

Key "+" / "-" operating instructions

- *Volume adjustment: Short press the "+" or "-" button;
- *Switch songs: Press and hold the "+" / "-" button for about 2 seconds to switch to the previous / next song.


3.Dual Link Function

(1)Bluetooth connection with a device.

(2) Turn off Bluetooth on device A, and connect Bluetooth with device B.



(3) Turn on the Bluetooth on A device and click the "DockPro" connection under the paired list. Complete two devices to connect to Bluetooth.



4.Notes

- Please stay away from liquids to avoid damage to the equipment,
- Do not disassemble the device privately,
- Please turn off the power when not using the device,
- In order to protect your hearing, please listen to the song at an appropriate volume. It is recommended that the single listening time should be within 2 hours.
- If the equipment is not used for a long time, turn on the equipment regularly to extend the service life of the product.

(2) Make sure the DockPro is in pairing state and the blue light is blinking.




(5) Device Settings.



(6) Echo Dot.




(7) Bluetooth Devices




(8) Pair a new Device
