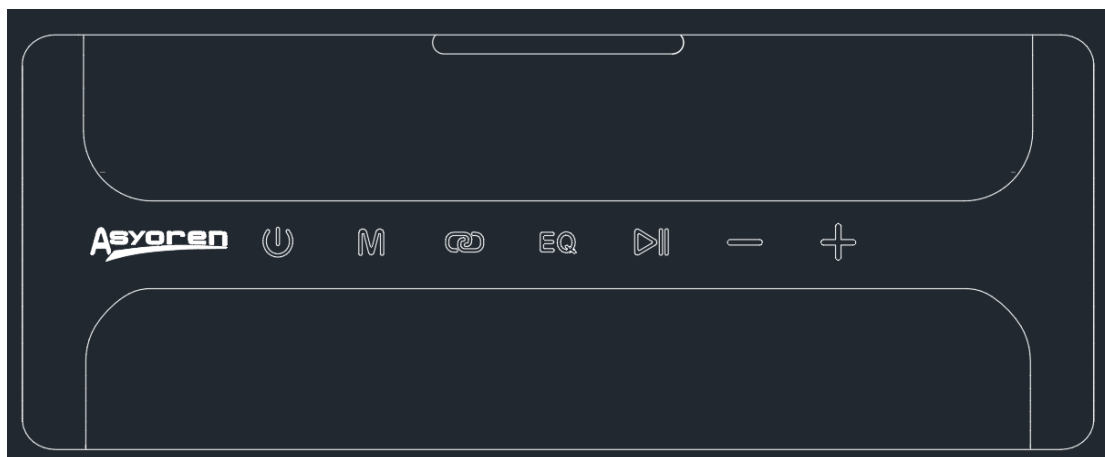

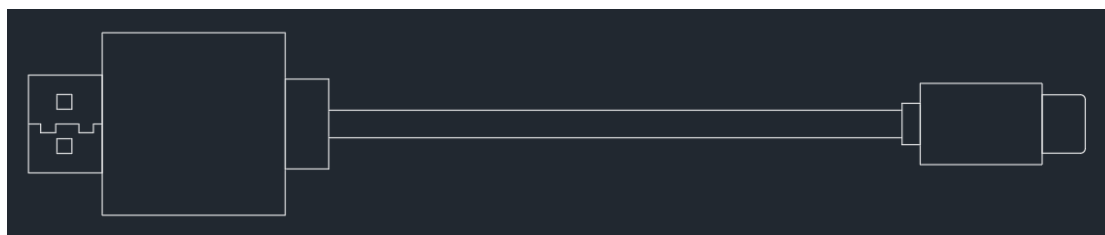

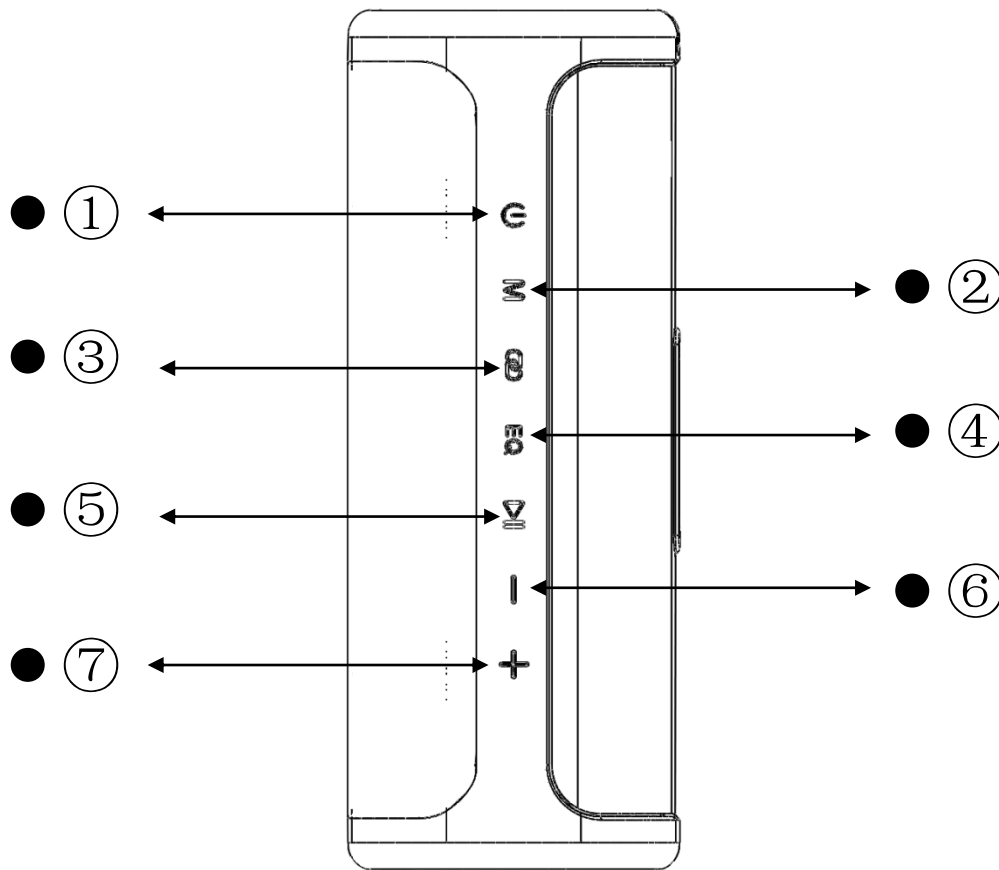


Asyoren A3 Wireless speaker x 1pcs

 - ⑦: Volume+ / Next
