



1. Power on/off button. Answer/hang up/reject incoming calls, music playback/pause
2. Multi-function buttons. Short press this button to switch betweenTF card/USB drive/ Bluetooth functions; Long press this button to initiate the cascade mode.
3. "+" button. Short press this button to increase the volume, long press this button to play the next track.
4. "-" button. Short press this button to decrease the volume, long press this button to play the previous track
5. Microphone hole
6. Atmosphere light button. Short press this button to switch the lighting mode, long press this button to turn off the lights.
7. Reset button

Power/Charging

To achieve a better user experience, please fully charge this product before using the speaker.A USB charging cable is included in the product packaging. Through this cable, this speakercan be charged by connecting to a USB port on the computer or other standard charging plugsthat are compatible with USB ports. Only the adapters of 5V/1A or above (not included) can be used for charging.When the speaker is being charged, the red LED indicator light will remain on. After being fully charged, the LED indicator light

of 5V/1A or above (not included) can be used for charging.When the speaker is being charged, the red LED indicator light will remain on. After being fully charged, the LED indicator light will be off automatically.

Note: Only the USB voltage output of the computer or the standard 5V power adapter can be used to charge the speaker. If a non-standard 5V USB power adapter is used to charge the speaker, the speaker may be damaged. Do not charge if the connector or device is damp or damaged.

ON/OFF

In shutdown mode, press and hold "ON/OFF" for approximately 2 seconds to turn on the speaker,accompanied by a power on prompt. Please press and hold "ON/OFF" again for

approximately 2 seconds to turn off the speaker, with the shutdown prompt sound.

Bluetooth connectivity

When the speaker is first used and turned on, it will automaticallyenter pairing mode. If you need to connect your phone through Bluetooth function, please enable the Bluetooth function of yourphone and search for a Bluetooth name named "A1" to connect in advance.

Volume control

Short press the "+" or "-" button for volume adjustment to increase or decrease the volume.

Music

Play/Pause: In the play mode, short press the "ON/OFF" button to play/pause music.Next track: In the play mode, press and hold the volume adjustment "+" button for 2 seconds to go to the next track.Previous track: In the play mode, press and hold the volume adjustment "-" button for 2 seconds to go to the previous track.

Call

Answer incoming calls: Short press the 'ON/OFF' button.Reject incoming calls: Double click the 'ON/OFF' buttonEnd the call: Short press the 'ON/OFF' button.

card play

When the TF card is inserted into the device and the speaker is turned on, the music in the TF card is prioritized for play. If the users need to play music through Bluetooth function, please press the "Multi-function button" to switch the audio source

USB play

When the USB flash is inserted into the device and the speaker is turned on, the music in the USB is prioritized for play. If the users need to play music through Bluetooth function, please press the "Multi-function button" to switch the audio source.

AUX (external audio input)

When turning on the phone, insert a 3.5mm audio

When turning on the phone, insert a 3.5mm audio cable and switch to AUX mode to play the music from the phone, MP3, and computer.

Atmosphere light

Short press the 'Atmosphere Light' button to switch betweenmultiple lighting modes. Press and hold this button for 2 seconds to turn off the ambient light.

Power saving settings

After the speaker is turned on, if it is not connected to a Bluetoothdevice, it will automatically shut down after 10 minutes.

Reset paired device list

After turning on the phone, press the "+" and "-" buttons simultaneously for 3 seconds without

any music playing or incoming calls.

Reset device

If a product malfunction occurs, please press the reset button.

Cascade function of multiple speakers (limited to the same model)

1. Open a Bluetooth speaker and connect it to a Bluetooth device (such as a phone).
2. Press and hold the 'Multi function button' to activate the cascade mode. When two devices are successfully connected, a prompt tone will be heard.
3. Open another Bluetooth speaker and long press the 'Multi function button' to activate the cascade mode. When two speakers come close, they will be automatically connected between them.

Reminder tone guide

| Status | Voice/sound prompts |
|---------------------|----------------------------|
| Power on | Startup prompt tone |
| Shutdown | Shutdown prompt tone |
| Bluetooth pairing | "Discovering" |
| Bluetooth connected | "Your device is connected" |
| Low battery | "Battery low" |
| Cascade on | "Broadcast mode" |
| Cascade off | "Broadcast mode exit" |

Note

- It is not recommended to replace the battery privately without permission.
