


# LINE VOLTAGE RF RGB REMOTE USER MANUAL

## Remote Functions



## Remote Pairing

1. switch off the power
2. hold down the "brightness increase" button for 5 seconds
3. switch on the power
4. led start flashing showing the remote is now fully paired to the controller
5. try the remote to see if it's working

## Remote Unpairing

- 1. switch off the power**
- 2. hold down the “brightness decrease” button for 5 seconds**
- 3. switch on the power**
- 4. led start flashing showing the remote is now fully unpaired to the controller**
- 5. try the remote to see if it's working**

## Safety

- Do not exceed max power 400W, overloading the controller may cause overheating, shorting, and possibly failure of controller.**
- Do not expose the controller or remote to direct or indirect moisture.**
- Always observe proper polarity when connecting power and load.**
