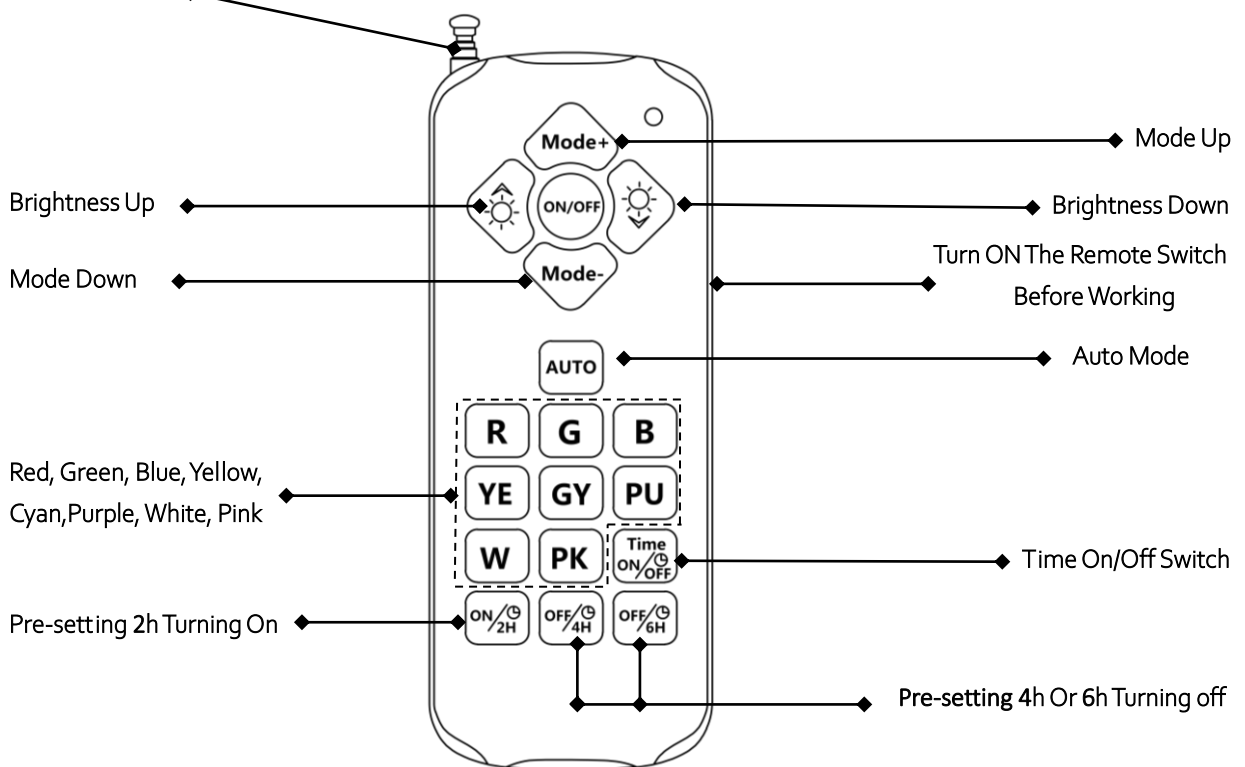




## 18-KEY RF REMOTE CONTROLLER(The Battery: 12V 23A)

Pull The Antenna As Long As Possible Before Using



**New Upgraded Brightness Mode:** Adjustable 5-level brightness (100%-25%), Not only adjust color brightness, but also can adjust lighting mode brightness.

**New Upgraded Memory Function:** Will stay at your lasting setting, while turn on again. Also can remember the dim level(Limited to turn on/off with remote, if power off more 5 minutes, turn on the light again, the light will keep 100% brightness).

**10 Lighting Mode:** M①: 7-Color Fade(no pink); M②:7-Color Slow Flash(no pink); M③:7-Color Breathe(no pink); M④:R G B W Fade; M⑤: R G B W Jump; M⑥:R G B Fade; M⑦:8-color Jump; M⑧:Red Fade+Jump; M⑨: Green Fade+Jump; M⑩:Blue Fade+Jump.

**Auto Lighting Mode:** 10 Lighting mode automatic cycle.

**Timer Mode:** Pre-setting the 2 hours turn on or make it turn off 4 hour or 6 hours automatically.

► **Note:** Press the time switch button, the green light will flash 3 times, which means the timer function is turned on, then setting the corresponding time to turn on or off,if the green light flashes 3 times again, which means the time setting successfully.
