

Packing List

1. Touchpad Keyboard for Surface Pro 7/6/5/4/3.
2. Type-C Charging Cable (No Charger).
3. Keyboard Manual.

Setup

Please lay the tablet horizontally and align it with the magnetic strip above the keyboard. The tablet will automatically attach to the keyboard.

Note: The keyboard does not support pin connection. If you want to use the keyboard function, please connect the keyboard and the tablet using Bluetooth. when using the bluetooth.

Connection

When using the keyboard for the first time, please charge it for 3-4 hours to ensure sufficient power.

1. Turn on the keyboard power . Keep pressing the keyboard power button for 3 seconds. (Charging light shows red and turns off for 2 seconds, then turns off).

2. Automatic pairing: the Pair light shows blue and keeps flashing which indicates the keyboard is under pairing mode.

3. Open Windows Settings-Devices-Bluetooth & Other Devices-Add Bluetooth or Other Devices-Bluetooth. Search for "Bluetooth keyboard 5.1 V72" and click to connect.

Keyboard Features

Keyboard Overview

① Pair Light	Press Fn+Z to enter Bluetooth pairing, the light flashes blue, and the pairing is completed and goes out.
② Caps light	Press the caps lock on the keyboard, the indicator light is blue.
③ Battery lower light	Flashes red when lower than 15% and recharge required.
④ Charging light	Charging: Steady Red charge complete: turn off light.
⑤ Reset key	When no button is pressed, use a needle to pry it and press down.
⑥ Power On/Off	Keep pressing the keyboard power button for 3 seconds. Charging light shows red and turns off for 2 seconds, then turns off.

Blacklit Instruction

1. Make sure the keyboard is connected to the device.

2. Single press the backlight key to switch the 3 levels of the backlight brightness.

3. Press keys to switch between 7 colors to adjust the backlight color.

4. When the battery power is lower than 20%, the blacklight turns off by itself and should not be turned on.

Note: Backlight Feature is only available on the backlight keyboard models.

Charge

1. For the first use, please use the charging cable to make the keyboard fully charged.

2. When charging, please check whether the charging port is powered normally.

Note: Please do not charge the keyboard for long time. Keeping it plugged in for a long time will deplete the keyboard's battery life.
