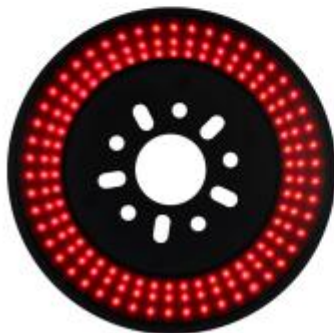
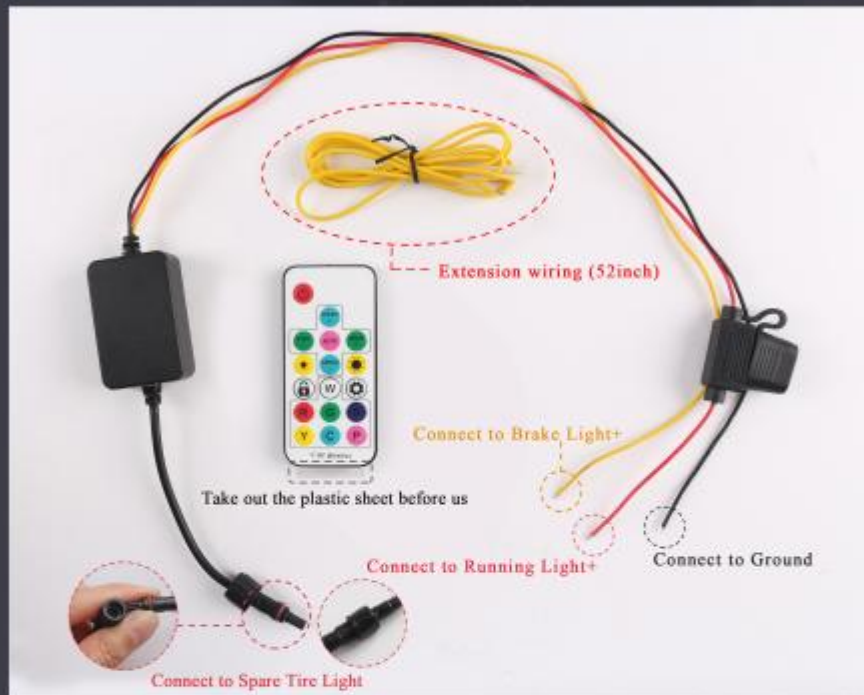

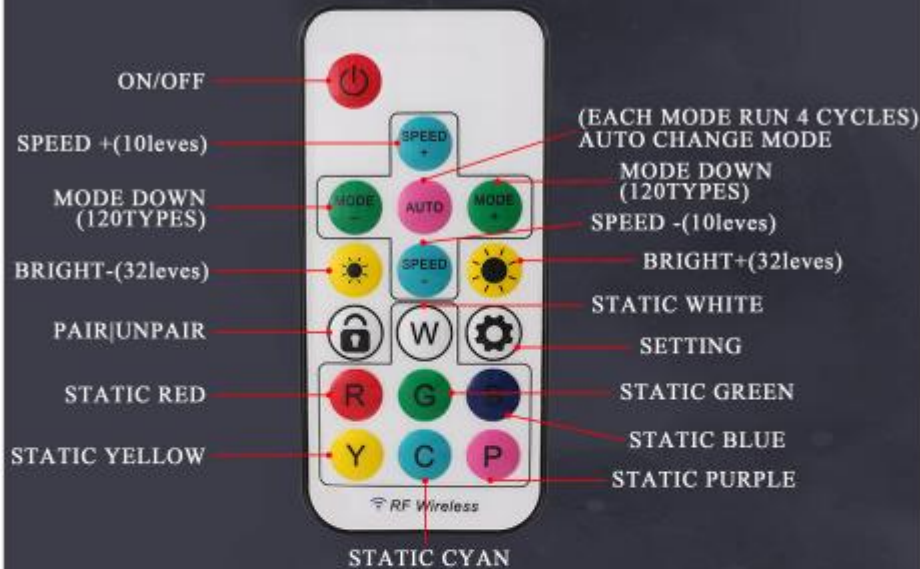


Brake Light

REMOTE CONTROL INSTRUCTION BOOK



NOTE: IF THE COLOR NOT MATCH WITH THE COTROLLER, IT'S BECAUSE OF THE "SETTING"PROBLEM, PLEASE FOLLOW THE STPES BELOW, THE PROBLEM WILL BE SOLVED:

- 1) Take out the plastic sheet, star the Engine, press ON/OFF button, press "SETTING" in 3 seconds, the Lamp turn into WHITE, means get into "SETTING" state;
- 2) In "SETTING" state, press "PAIR/UNPAIR" button, if the Spare Tire Light flash RED, means "CODE Mismatching"; press "PAIR/UNPAIR" button again, if the Spare Tire Light flash GREEN, means "CODE Matching";
- 3) In "SETTING" state, press "R" over and over again, until the Lamp turn into RED, press "G" over and over again, until the Lamp turn into GREEN, then succeed to setting-up RGB Sequence;
- 4) Press "SETTING" button, exit "SETTING" state. Attention: must exit "SETTING" state by "SETTING" button, otherwise the above operations will not reserve.

User Manual:

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:
