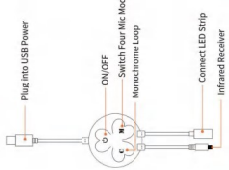

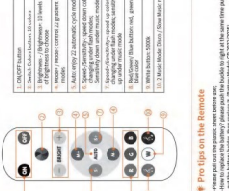

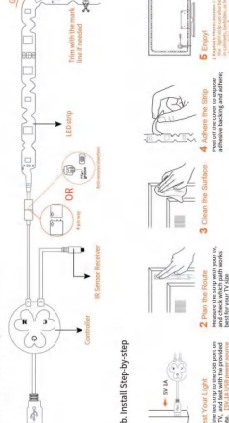

## Troubleshooting

| Symptom                                  | Possible Causes                       | Solution                                             |

| LED strip does not work after "Turn off" | LED strip is not plugged in properly. | Turn off the strip lights and plug them in properly. |
| LED strip does not work after "Turn on"  | LED strip is not plugged in properly. | Turn off the strip lights and plug them in properly. |

## Control Method

The LED strip lights have multiple control methods. Remote + APP + TV.

1. Remote Control

2. APP Control

3. TV Control

## How to use the remote

Step 1: Press the "Power" button on the remote to turn on the LED strip lights.

Step 2: Press the "Mode" button to cycle through the different light modes.

Step 3: Press the "Brightness" button to adjust the brightness of the lights.

Step 4: Press the "Color" button to change the color of the lights.

## How to use the APP

Step 1: Download the "LED Strip Lights" APP from the App Store or Google Play.

Step 2: Connect the LED strip lights to the APP.

Step 3: Control the LED strip lights using the APP.

## How to use the TV

Step 1: Connect the LED strip lights to the TV.

Step 2: Control the LED strip lights using the TV remote.

## How to use the IR Remote

Step 1: Point the IR remote at the LED strip lights.

Step 2: Press the buttons on the remote to control the lights.

## How to use the LED Strip

Step 1: Plug the LED strip into the power source.

Step 2: Turn on the LED strip lights.
