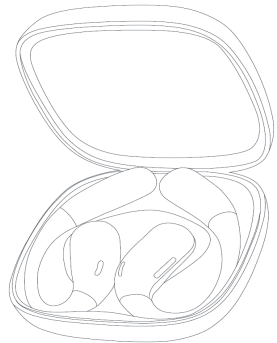


Instruction manual



This diagram illustrates the components of the JBL Charge 3. - The headset is in the box. Take out the headset and turn it on automatically
- The headset is turned off outside the case, and long press the function key for 3 seconds to turn it on
- Put it in the charging case and turn it off
- In the startup state, hold down 5S to power off
- Low power, unconnected devices automatically shut down

- Turn on the device, search for "A38" and select Connect
 - When the device is powered on for the first time, it automatically enters the Bluetooth pairing state
 - When the device is turned on again, the headset automatically connects back to the previous device.
- After the connection fails, the headset automatically enters the pairing mode

Pause/Play	Click the function key
Next song	Triple-click the right function key
Previous song	Triple-click the left function key
Volume up	Double-click the right ear function key
Volume down	Double-click the left ear function key
Voice assistant	Press and hold the left function button for 3 seconds
Game/Music mode	Press and hold the right function button for 3 seconds
Answer/End the call	Click the function key
Reject a call	Press and hold the function button for 1.5 seconds
Undial	Click the function key during the dialing process

1. When using one ear, the operation is the right ear.
2. If the left and right earbuds are not paired, turn on the device and disconnect it from the device, quickly click the function button on the left and right earbuds, put it into the charging case, and take it out to re-pair.

Maintenance and upkeep

- When the earbuds are not in use, please put the earbuds back into the charging case to prevent loss and charge the earbuds in time.
- Before cleaning and maintenance, stop using this device, turn off all apps, and disconnect all connections or cables to other devices.
- Please use a clean, dry, soft cloth to wipe down the device or its accessories.
- If the product with a lithium battery is not used for a long time, please make sure to charge it at least once every three months.

Before using and operating the equipment, please read and follow the following precautions to ensure optimal performance of the equipment and to avoid dangerous or illegal situations.

- **Electronic equipment:** Do not use this equipment in places where the use of wireless devices is expressly prohibited, otherwise it will interfere with other electronic devices or cause other dangers.
- **Impact on medical devices:** The radio waves generated by the device may affect the normal operation of implantable medical devices or personal medical devices, such as pacemakers, cochlear implants, hearing aids, etc. If you use any of these medical devices, check with their manufacturers about restrictions on using this device.
