- To turn on your device press the power button and to turn off, press again or follow the instructions in the RÉDUIT app.
- When not in use or traveling, Keep the RÉDUIT device in its designated pouch.

2. CHARGING

When the battery is low, your RÉDUIT device will flash red.

- Connect the RÉDUIT device to a power outlet using the included USB-C cable.
- Your RÉDUIT device will glow red and pulse gently to indicate battery is charging.
- A solid green light will indicate when your RÉDUIT device is fully charged.

Use this device only for its intended use as described in this manual. If you experience any discomfort, discontinue use immediately and consult a physician. 
