1-Step Easy Connection

Bluetooth version of the headset connection steps

- 1.Headset inserted into the phone charging port
- 2.Pop-up windows appear on the phone screen
- 3.Click connect via iCloud
- 4.The pop-up window will be closed automatically after successful connection

Attention

- 1.Wired Bluetooth Earbuds--Turn on Bluetooth before plugging in the headphones. Then click "Connect with iCloud" .
- 2.They will automatically connect in 2-5 seconds when you plug in the next time. If the first connection is not successful, please click "Try again" to reconnect, because this wired Bluetooth headset needs to be paired with your phone model.
- 3.This wired Bluetooth headset has a pairing memory function, so after connecting two phones, you need to delete the previous Bluetooth connection record when you connect to the next phone.
