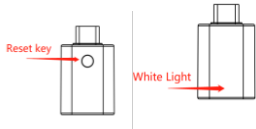
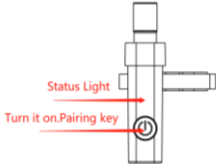


Collar Wireless microphone		
Pictorial Representation	Adapters 	Microphones 
Function and usage	Long press the adapter reset button for 3 seconds (white flash) to pair with the microphone or the Bluetooth headset	Reset the microphone (press the on/off button for 5 seconds to flash white and blue for 2 seconds) , then press the on/off button to flash white and blue alternately to pair with the Iphone or adapter
Quick use of iphone 		Reset the microphone (press the on/off button for 5 seconds until the white-blue button flashes for 2 seconds) , press the microphone for a short time to switch on (alternate white-blue flashing) and connect it to the IPHONE' s Bluetooth, the iphone and the microphone have been successfully linked together, the company said
Quick use of Android TYPE-C phones 	Plug the adapter into the phone' s TYPE-C port to make the adapter a wireless headset (some phones require Otg) . There will be an earphone icon in the top right corner of the phone 	After the microphone is reset (press for 5 seconds to Flash for 2 seconds at the same time while the power is off) , then press the microphone to power on (alternate flashing of white and blue) and connect to the adapter (press the reset button for 3 seconds to flash the white light) . When the microphone is long blue and the adapter is long white, the connection between the microphone and the adapter is successful
Rapid computer use 	The adapter plugs into the computer via a USB adapter, making the adapter a non-drive wireless sound card (the computer Device Manager can see RTL5686) . Select your input and output devices in the audio settings 	After the microphone is reset (press the microphone for 5 seconds to Flash Blue and white simultaneously for 2 seconds when the power is off) , then press the microphone to power on (white and blue flash alternately) and connect to the adapter (press the reset button for 3 seconds to flash the white light) . When the microphone has a long blue light and the adapter has a long white light, this means the microphone and the adapter have been connected successfully,
