	Power On	In all status, press MFB to power on.
	Power Off	In on status, long press 5 seconds to power off.
	Enter into Pairing Mode	In all status, automatic enter into pairing mode.
MFB	Connection	Connect for the first time. When there is a pairing record, power on and enter into the auto-connect state.
	Answer a Call	Short press (when call coming)
	Hang up a Call	Short press (during a call)
	Reject a Call	Long press 1 second (when call coming)
