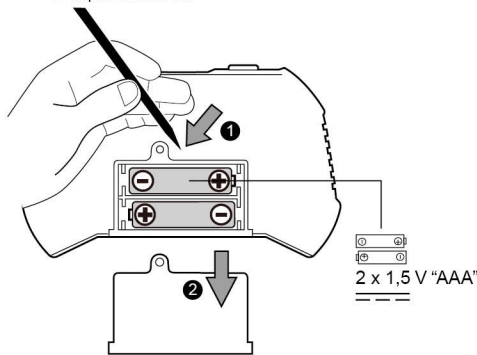

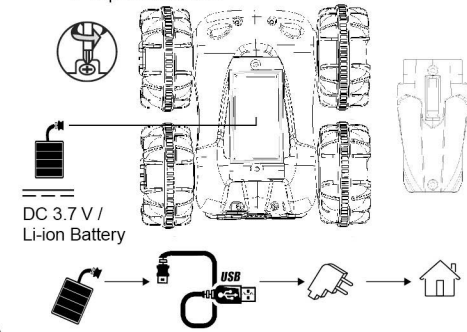
A Installing batteries in the Remote Control:

- 1 - Open the battery compartment.
- 2 - Insert batteries, respecting the + and - polarities.
- 3 - Replace the cover.



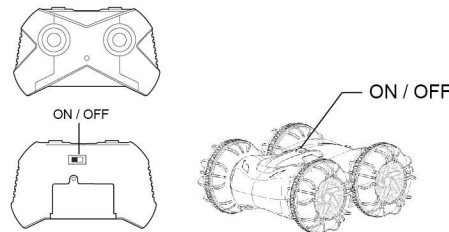
B Installing the vehicle battery:

- 1 - Make sure the ON/OFF switch is set to OFF.
- 2 - Open the battery compartment.
- 3 - Connect the battery to the vehicle.
- 4 - Replace the cover.

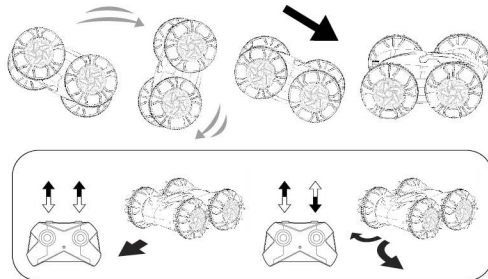


C Instruction:

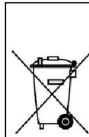
- 1 - Start the car.
- 2 - To move the car forwards or backwards, push the throttle lever forwards or backwards or press the trigger (depending on the model).
- 3 - To turn the vehicle left or right, press the steering lever to the left or right. Or, depending on the model, turn the steering wheel or move the 2 levers in opposite directions to turn.



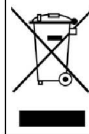
- 4 - To stop the vehicle, release the throttle lever.
- 5 - 360° flip the vehicle, go straight-on on the remote control and suddenly go backward the vehicle will flip and then go forward. You can also do the inverse.
- 6 - The vehicle also can drive on water.

- Do not use the vehicle with the radio control in the street. Avoid collisions with people, animals and furniture.
- Warning: any change or modification made to this product that is not expressly approved in the relevant section of the declaration of conformity may terminate the usage authorisation granted to the user.
- USB cable statement:
 - If battery cannot be charged. Please try another adapter.
 - The product must only be used with the provided USB cable for charging.
 - Do not use high output adapter for battery charging (1A or above).
 - Transformer or battery charger used with the toy are to be regularly examined for damage to the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts, and in the event of such damage, they must not be used until the damage has been repaired.


Battery warning:

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. (transmitter)
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged. (vehicle)
- Rechargeable batteries should be charged under adult supervision.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed. (transmitter)
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used. (transmitter)
- Batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity. (+ and -) (transmitter)
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Do not mix old and new batteries. (transmitter)
- Do not mix alkaline batteries, standard batteries (carbon-zinc) and rechargeable batteries (nickel-cadmium). (transmitter)
- Caution: first charge must be not less than 4h to optimize battery efficiency


Care and maintenance:

- Always remove the batteries from the toy if it is not used for a long time.
- Wipe the toy gently with a clean cloth.
- Keep the toy away from direct sources of heat.
- Replace batteries when they become less powerful.
- Operation temperature 5 - 35°C
- Receiver Category 3
- Do not immerse the product in water unless the battery compartment is properly closed and locked.
- The toy is to be operated in water only fully assembled in accordance with the instructions.
- Do not drive in salty water.
- Operate on smooth water, such as pools and ponds.
- Never immerse remote control in water.
- Always remove product from water when not in use.
- Keep the product away from obstacles / peoples or animals in pool.
- Charger Statement:
 - Do not operate battery charger if it has been damaged in anyway.
 - This product must only be used with the recommended charger.
