


Function Description

- 1.Zoom in/out: Zoom the image in 1X, 2X or 4X
- 2.MENU: On homepage, press to enter the menu interface
- 3.Direction/OK button: Rotate the camera direction, adjust the angle; select the function on menu page/Confirm.
- 4.Two way call button: Make a call after pressing the button
- 5.ON/OFF button: Press with 5 seconds to turn on and turn off the display

10.SD card slot: Support local SD Card storage (Max.128G)


11.Rest port: Press with pin to reset the display
