



WARNING PART.2

Turn off the unit if an abnormality or malfunction occurs

In the following cases, immediately turn off the power and then contact your dealer or authorized service center for service.

- If smoke or unusual odor occurs; or
- Objects have fallen into, or liquid has been spilled into the case; or
- The unit has been exposed to rain (or otherwise has become wet); or
- The unit does not appear to operate normally or exhibits a marked change in performance.

Be cautious to protect children from injury

Always make sure that an adult is on hand to provide supervision and guidance when using the unit in places where children are present, or when a child will be using the unit.

Do not drop or subject to strong impact

Otherwise, you risk causing damage or malfunction.

Handling units that contain a lithium-ion battery

Do not use, recharge, or leave the unit in a location that is subject to high temperature

- In direct sunlight
- Near a fire
- Inside a vehicle on a hot day, etc.

Do not leave the unit recharging for an extended time

When recharging is completed, disconnect the power supply used for recharging; do not leave the power supply connected for an extended time.

CAUTION

Avoid climbing on top of the unit, or placing heavy objects on it

Otherwise, you risk injury as the result of the unit toppling over or dropping down.

Keep small items out of the reach of children

To prevent accidental ingestion of the unit or the components, accessories, always keep them out of the reach of small children.

Please avoid using the LED indicator near the eyes of children or animals

Precautions if liquid leaks from the product

If liquid leaks from the internal lithium-ion battery, observe the following precautions.

- Do not touch the liquid with your bare hands.
- If any of the leaking fluid gets into your eyes, the loss of vision may result. Do not rub your eyes; use clean water to flush them thoroughly. Then, promptly see a doctor.
- Burning of the skin or dermatitis may result if fluid has gotten onto your skin or clothing. Use clean water to flush affected areas thoroughly; then, promptly see a doctor.

IMPORTANT NOTES PART.1

Power Supply: Use of Batteries

- This product is equipped with a lithium-ion battery.
- Even if you do not use this product for an extended period of time, you should charge it once every three months to prevent the internal lithium-ion battery from degrading.
- Ambient temperature range during charging 5–35°C. However, in order to take full advantage of the rechargeable lithium-ion battery's performance, we recommend that you charge it in a temperature range of 10–30°C.
- If you need to dispose of this product, do not simply discard it with your household waste; if the internal lithium-ion battery becomes unusable, you should dispose of it in compliance with local regulations.
- This unit contains a lithium-ion battery. When disposing of this unit, please observe the regulations applicable to your locality. Never remove the lithium-ion battery. Doing so may cause bursting or fire.

Placement

- This unit may interfere with radio and television reception. Do not use this unit in the vicinity of such receivers.
- Do not contact the magnetic stripe card (such as bank card, telephone card, etc.) with the equipment for a long time, otherwise the magnetic stripe card may be damaged by the magnetic field.
- When moved from one location to another where the temperature and/or humidity is very different, water droplets (condensation) may form inside the unit. Damage or malfunction may result if you attempt to use the unit in this condition. Therefore, before using the unit, you must allow it to stand for several hours, until the condensation has completely evaporated. NEVER use external heating equipment such as microwave oven or hair dryer to dry it.
- Do not place containers or anything else containing liquid on top of this unit. Also, whenever any liquid has been spilled on the surface of this unit, be sure to promptly wipe it away using a soft, dry cloth.

Maintenance

- Never use benzine, thinners, alcohol or solvents of any kind, to avoid the possibility of discoloration and/or deformation.

Additional Precautions

- Use a reasonable amount of care when using the unit's buttons, sliders, or other controls; and when using its jacks and connectors. Rough handling can lead to malfunctions.
- When disconnecting all cables, grasp the connector itself—never pull on the cable. This way you will avoid causing shorts, or damage to the cable's internal elements.
- To avoid disturbing others nearby, try to keep the unit's volume at reasonable levels.
- When disposing of the packing carton or cushioning material in which this unit was packed, you must observe the waste disposal regulations that apply to your locality.

Caution Regarding Radio Frequency Emissions

- The following actions may subject you to penalty of law.
 - Disassembling or modifying this device.
 - Removing the certification label affixed to the back of this device.
