



Check whether the product is charged fully and Ultrasonic cartridge is connected. Refer to the article 2.3 for more details how to change the cartridge.

1 Wash your face and wipe off moisture thoroughly.

2 Apply the provided **Gel** to the target area.

3 Press the **Power(●)** button 2 ~ 3 seconds to turn the product on and then LED window shows the Ultrasonic mode.

 If you don't use it for 3 minutes, the product will be turned off automatically.

5 Keep pressing the **SHOT(●)** button to use the Ultrasonic and keep moving the product. While using the Ultrasonic, you can see the number of remain shots through the LED window. It is possible to use over 100,000 shots.

1 Wash your face and wipe off moisture thoroughly.

2 Apply the provided **Gel** to the target area.

3 Press the **Power(●)** button 2 ~ 3 seconds to turn the product on and then LED window shows the Ultrasonic mode.

 If you don't use it for 3 minutes, the product will be turned off automatically.
