Turn ON/OFF

- (1) Press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for 1.5 seconds to turn it on, the blue light flashes quickly, and enter pairing mode.
- (2) Press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for 3 seconds to turn off, and accompanied by a tone.

Connect Bluetooth Devices

- (1) Turn on phone bluetooth and find the name, "BT-Music" or "MUSICROSS" select the device to complete the bluetooth pairing.
- (2) After the pairing was successful, the blue light flashes for 5 seconds.
- (3) Bluetooth automatically disconnects from a long distance and returns to bluetooth within 8 meters within 3 minutes.
- (4) The bluetooth will automatically shut down after 8 minutes if without any connection.

Voice Call

- (1) Click the **ON/OFF** button to answer when an incoming call comes in, click again to hang up the call.
- (2) Press the **ON/OFF** button for 2 seconds to reject the incoming call and hear a tone.
- (3) When the second call comes, click the **ON/OFF** button to answer the second call and hold both calls. Click again to hang up the second call and hold the current call.
- (4) Double-click the **ON/OFF** button to dial the most recently dialed number.

Play Music

- (1) Short press the **ON/OFF** button to switch pause/play.
- (2) Short press "+" or "-" to adjust the volume.
- (3) Long press "_" for the next or previous song
