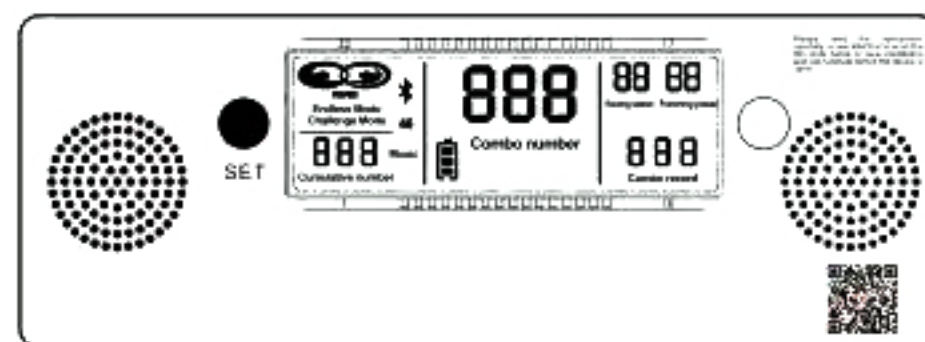

### Attention:

1. Fix the device on a solid wall. Hit it within the lamp circle. Don't hit the corners and display area to avoid hand injury or device damage. (Note: Damage to the display should be repaired at your own expense)
2. Not suitable for children under 5 years old. Children over 5 years old must be used under the supervision of adults. Leg and knee strikes are prohibited. Beginners do not hit too hard to avoid hand injury.
3. If the device cannot be turned on or is abnormal, check whether the power is too low. Charge the device in time and the duration shouldn't exceed 8 hours. Charge it once every 1-2 months even if it isn't used for a long time.
4. The device is not waterproof, don't wash. Don't dismantle the device when cleaning. Only use a wet towel to wipe the surface.

### Troubleshooting:

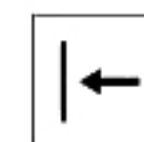
Fault	Reason analysis	Eliminating methods
1. The display is not on	Not boot	Hold the SET for three seconds
2. The display is not on	Loss of battery	Please charge
3. The display flickered on	Battery capacity is too low	Please charge
4. No data is showed on the display after the strike	Too little punch	Try to punch harder
5. Unable to boot after long press SET	Power shortage of main chip capacitor caused by long-term non startup	Long press the SET repeatedly
6. The internal crash sound of the tester	Emanating from an internally active stressed structure	Normal phenomenon

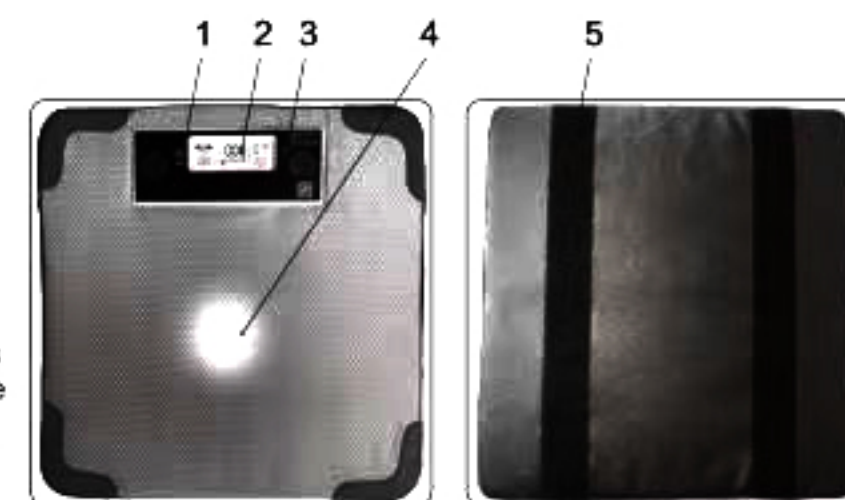

Long press SET for three seconds — Startup & Shutdown  
Short press SET for one seconds — Blacklight switch  
Short press SET for two seconds — Mode switch  
Short press SET for three seconds — Music switch  
No background music in Endless Mode  
The device will sleep after 5 minutes and automatically shut down after 20 minutes
