The textbook switch only has ON/OFF function




The light pole is screwed onto the bottom disc mount through the screw hole at the bottom



Connect the power plug of the light pole to the plug of the power adapter and then plug the adapter into the socket

● Remote Control Pairing



Pair Button

Press and hold the pairing button until the light starts flashing. After the light flashes three times, pairing is completed.

Cleaning & Maintenance

1. Avoid prolonged exposure to heat sources to prevent glazing, melting, scorching, or color fading.
2. Vacuum or lightly brush to remove dirt regularly.
3. Check screws periodically (every 90 days) to ensure they remain fully tightened.
