
Charging



Plug your headphones in to a power source using the included USB-B cable.




Rapidly flashing red when low battery

Solid red light turn OFF when fully charged




Setup and Bluetooth Pairing

- ① Turn on **Bluetooth** in your device settings. Press the **ON/OFF Button** until the status light flashes **blue and red**.




- ② Select "**Rockpapa E7**" in the Devices list, then click **Connect**. Status light slowly **flashing blue** when Bluetooth **paired**.



Music and call control

- Press once to **increase volume**
Press and hold to **skip forward**
- Press once to **play, pause music**
Press once to **answer, end a phone call**
Press and hold to **reject a phone call**
- Press once to **decrease volume**
Press and hold to **skip back**
- Press to **power ON or OFF**
