



BATTERIES (NOT INCLUDED)

BATTERY SAFETY

- KEEP BATTERIES AWAY FROM CHILDREN.
- THE BATTERY MUST BE REPLACED BY AN ADULT.
- THE BATTERY CAN ONLY BE CHARGED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF AN ADULT. DO NOT LEAVE THE RECHARGEABLE BATTERY UNATTENDED.
