


# Before You Start

## BUTTON CONTROLS




- 💡 Short press to turn on/off the light, change the light color  
Long press to adjust the brightness
- ▶ Press once to change next song, long press it to increase the volume.
- ◀ Press once to change last song, long press it to reduce the volume.
- ✳ Long press this button to active bluetooth mode.  
Short press to answer phone calling, speak directly to mirror by built-in microphone.
- ⚡ Short press to turn on/ off the light.
