



Instructions

Turn on the headphones: Press and hold the Power Button until the LED Indicator flashes blue and red alternately. Speaker will say: "Power on".

Turn off the headphones: Press and hold the Power Button until the LED Indicator flashes red. Speaker will say: "Power off".

Adjust volume: Click the Volume + button once so sound when the volume is at its max. Click the Volume - button once so sound when the volume is at its min.

Pairing:

1. Start with Elibom turned off.
2. Press and hold the power button until the LED Indicator flashes red and blue alternately.

Play/pause music: Click the multifunction button once.

Previous song: Long press the Volume - button while music is playing.

Next song: Long press the Volume + button while music is playing.

Answer call: Click the multifunction button once.

End call: Click the multifunction button once during a call.

Switch between English and Japanese: Press Volume + & Volume - at the same time and hold for 2 seconds.


Charging tips

When the headphones are at low battery, there will be a "battery low" prompt and the light will flash intermittently. Use the corresponding cable for charging.

Wear

Wearing your headphones the wrong way could cause discomfort. The transducers should rest in front of your ears.

Multifunction Button




① USB-C Charging Port

Restore factory settings



1. Double click on the multifunction button to switch between Bluetooth mode and Micro SD card mode.
2. Micro SD support up to 128GB music storage.
