1. Limit for Portable Equipment Exposure

Frequency	1-g SAR	
100MHz-6GHz	3.0 STATE A	

According to KDB 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v06 and part 2.1093 For 100 MHz to 6 GHz and test separation distances \leq 50 mm, the 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds are determined by the following:

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW) / (min. test separation distance, mm)] • [$\sqrt{f(GHz)}$] ≤ 3.0 for 1-g SAR, and ≤ 7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR, where

f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz

2. Estimation Result

Frequency (MHz)	PK Output Power(dBm)	Output Power(mW)	Test Separation Distance (mm)	Measurement Result	1-g SAR
2420	-1.91	0.644	5 5	0.0021	3.0

Note

- use the maximum E-field strength(93.29dBuV/m) for the RF exposure evaluation
- 2. E(dBuV/m)=EIRP(dBm)-95.2 for distance 3m so the EIRP=93.29dBuV/m-95.2=-1.91dBm
