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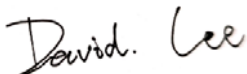

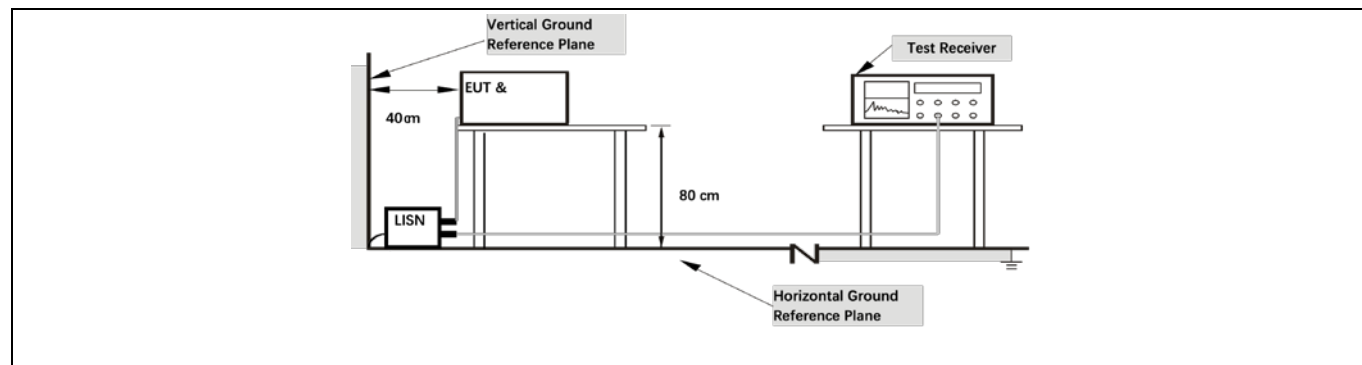

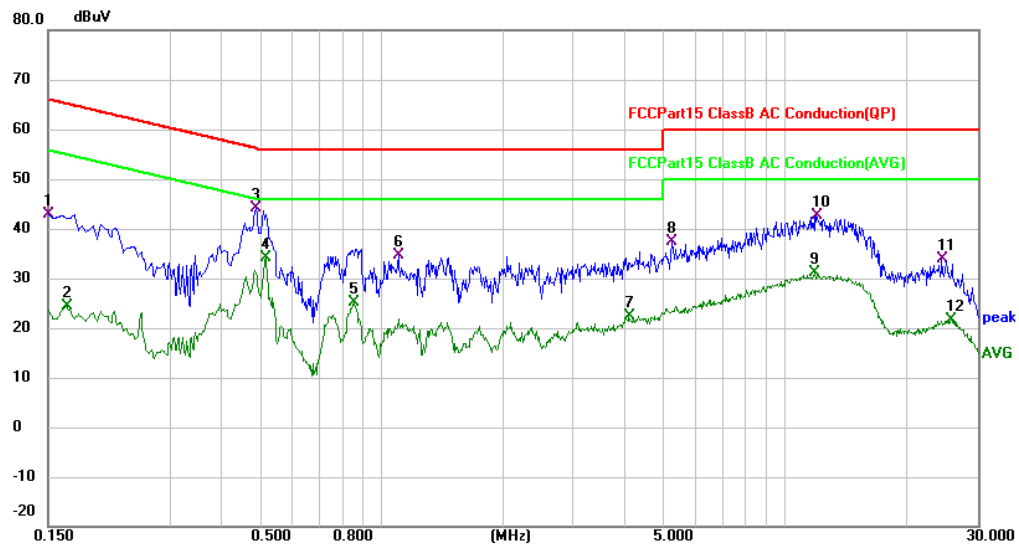

#### 6.1.2 Test Setup Diagram:



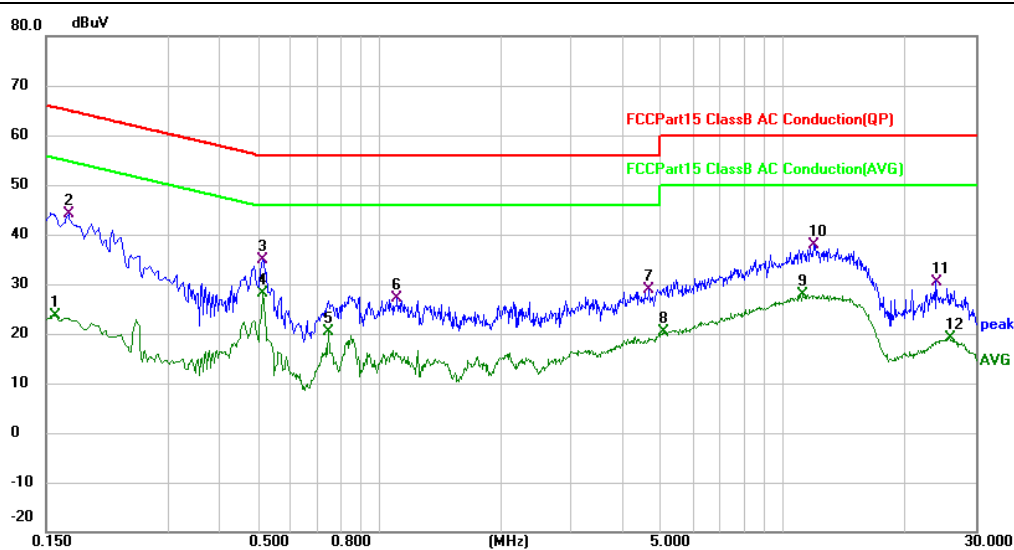

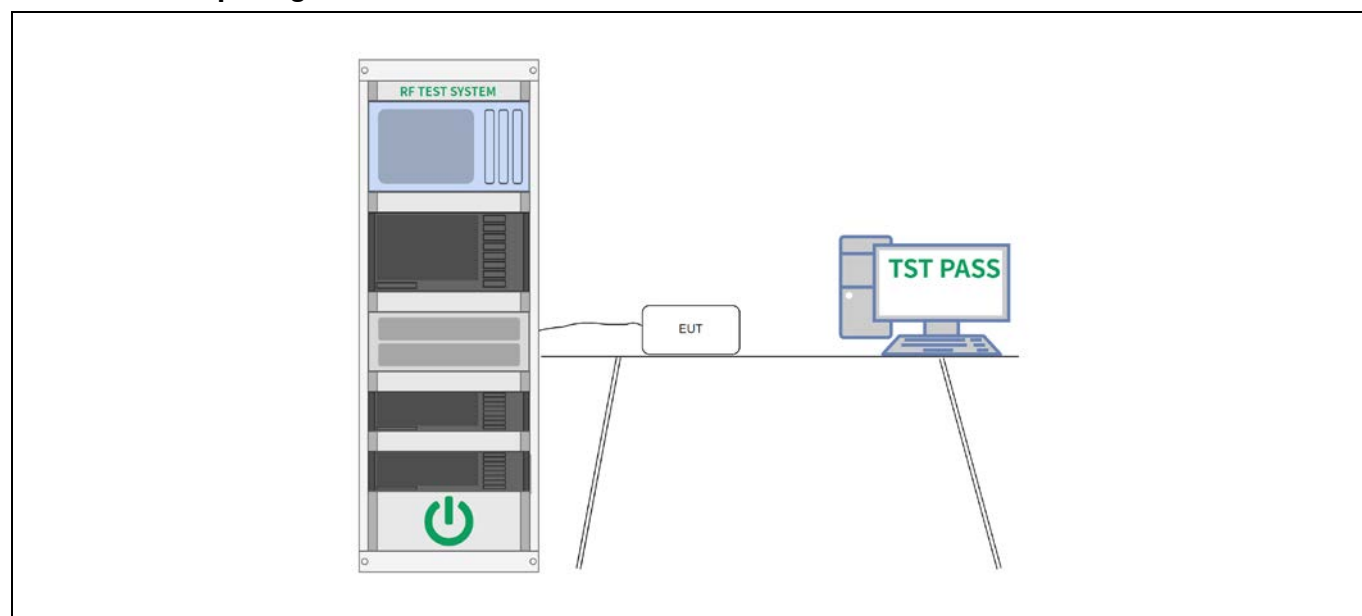

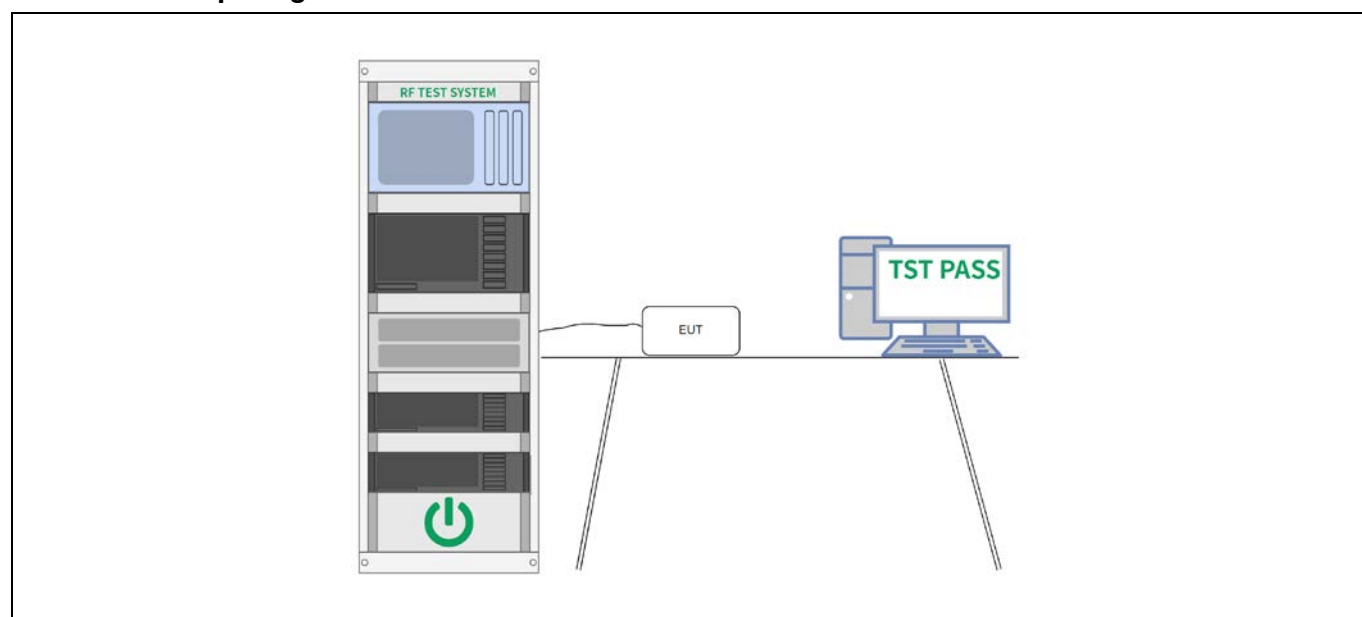

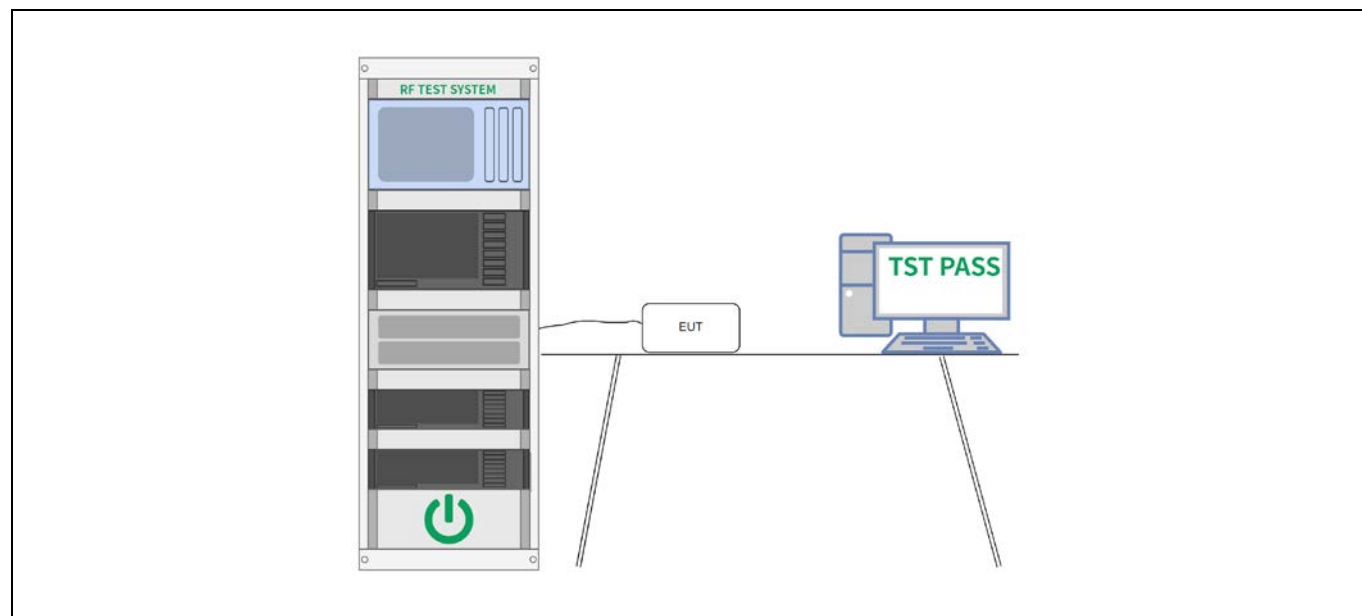

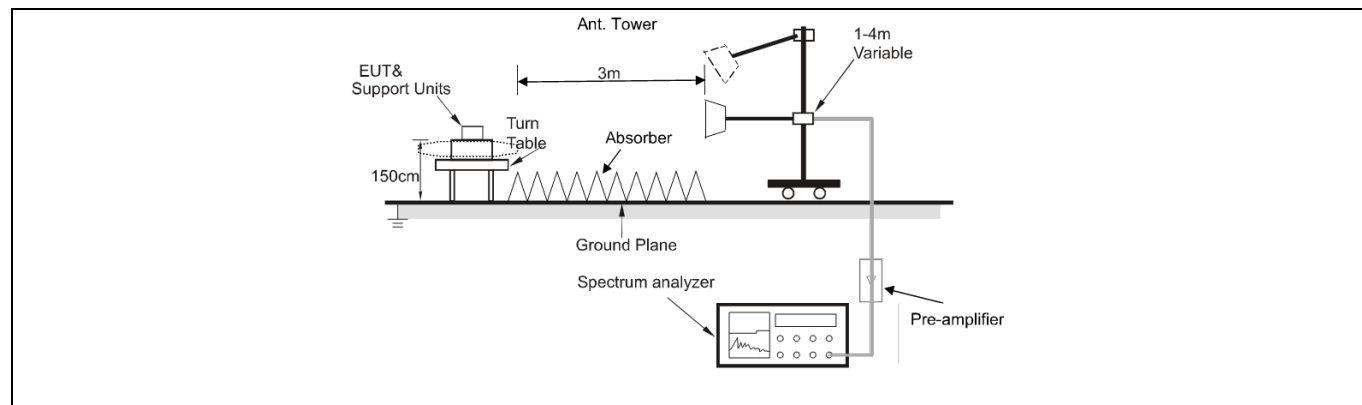

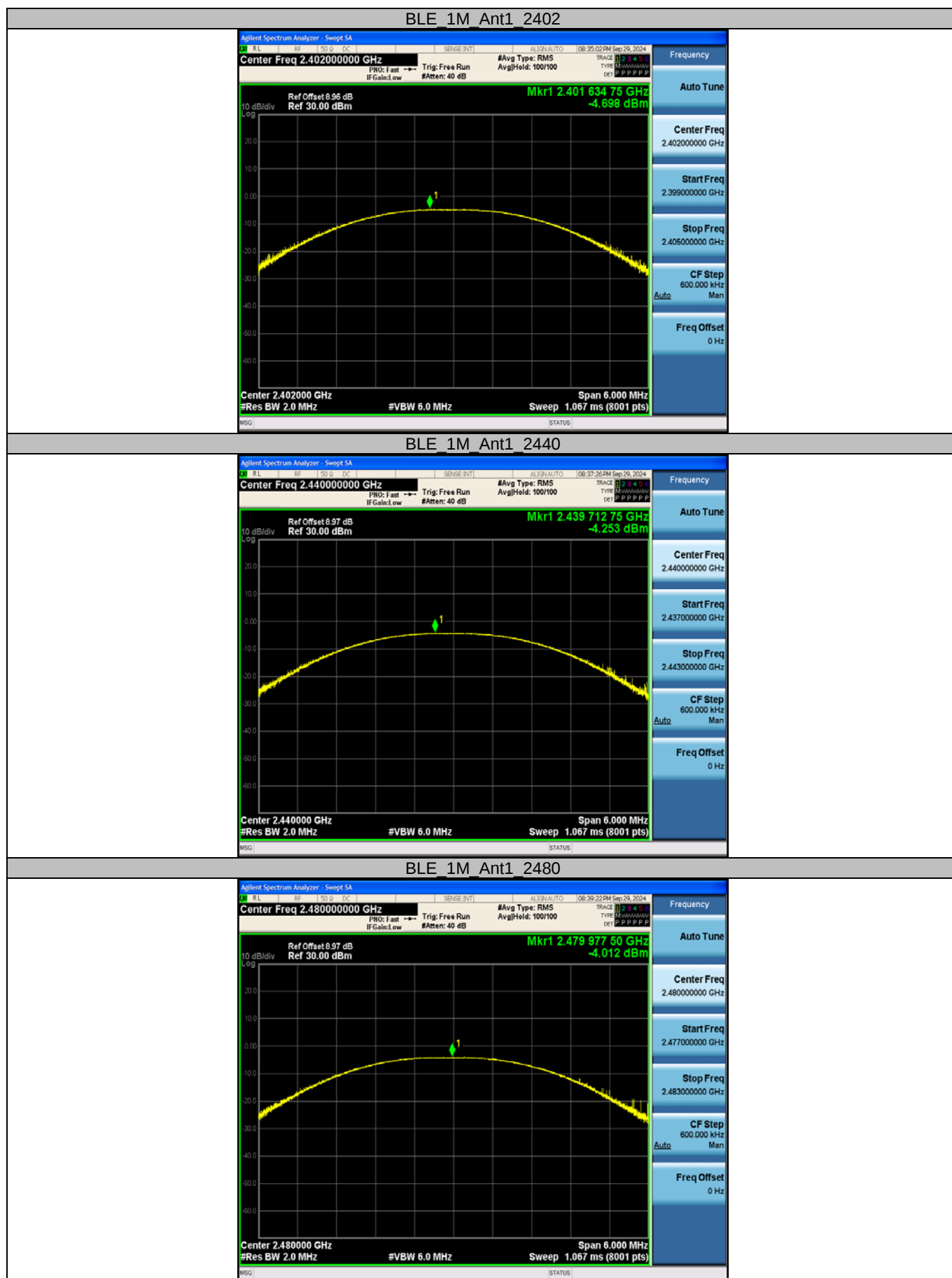

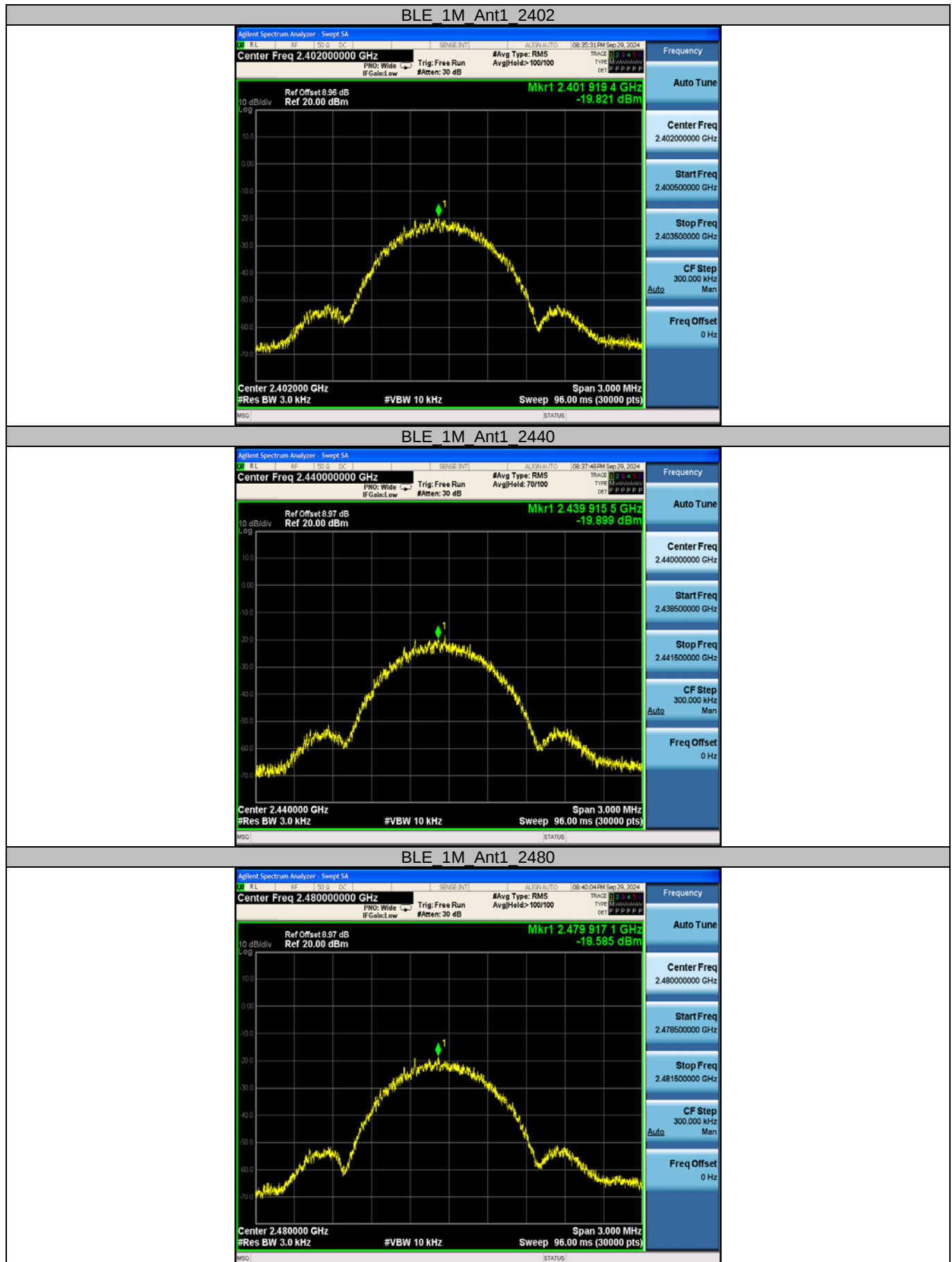

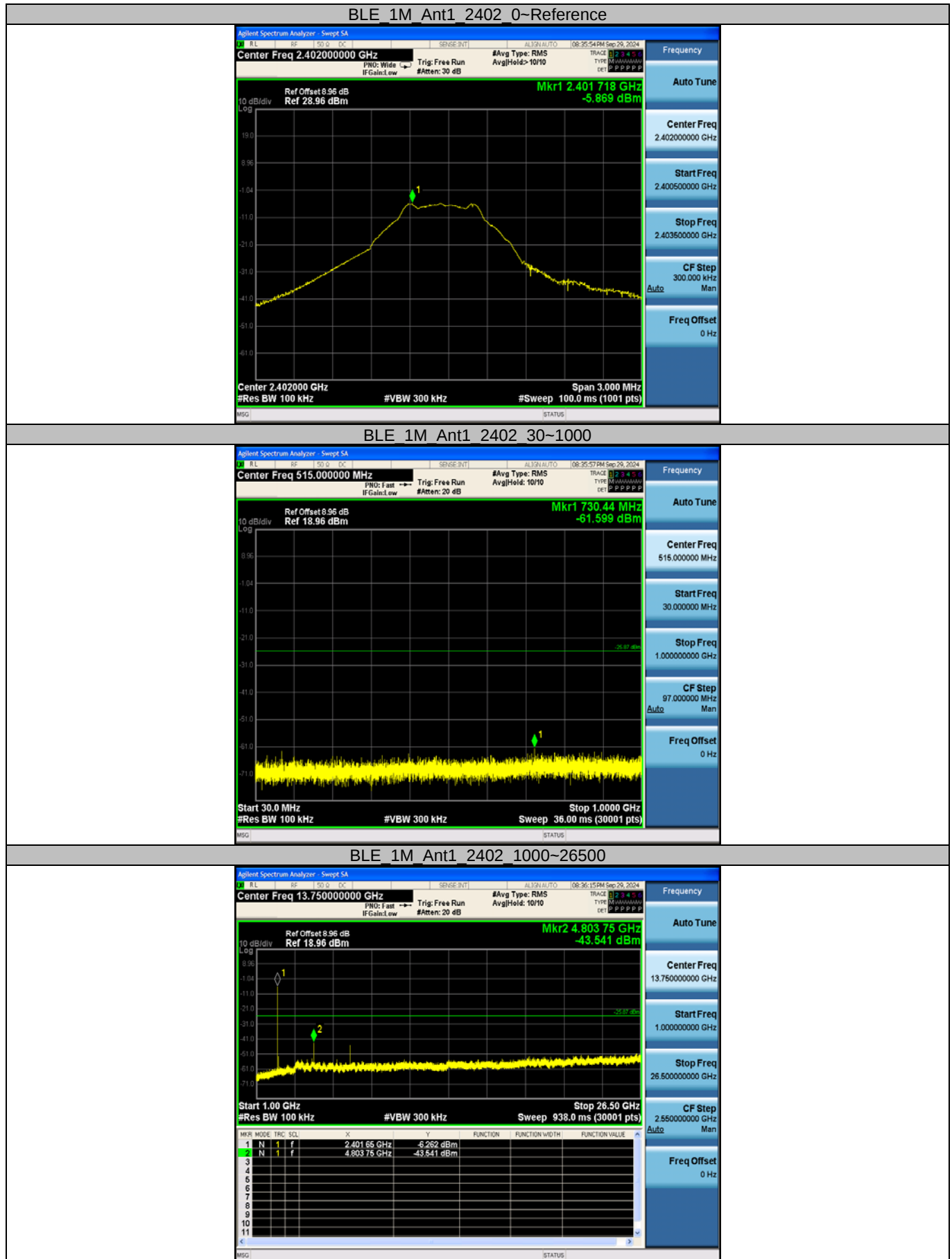

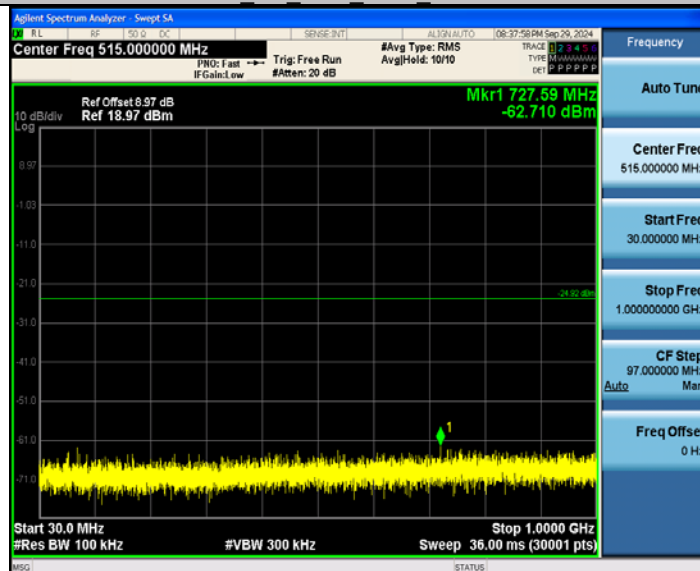

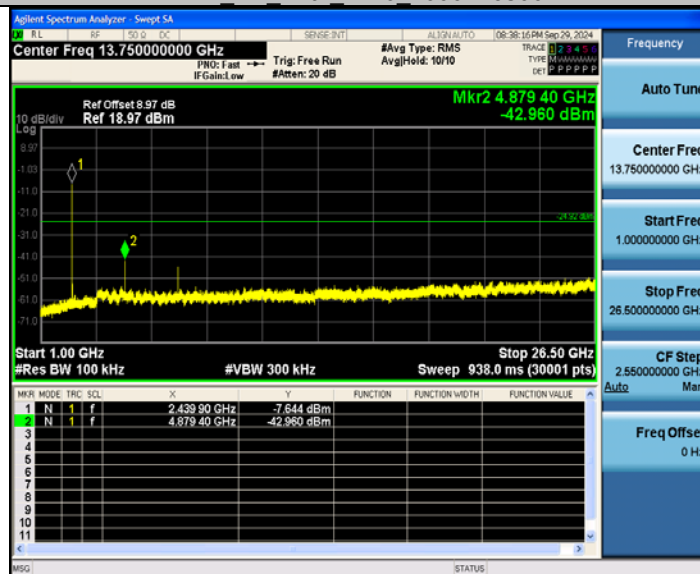
## BLE 1M Ant1 2440 0~Reference



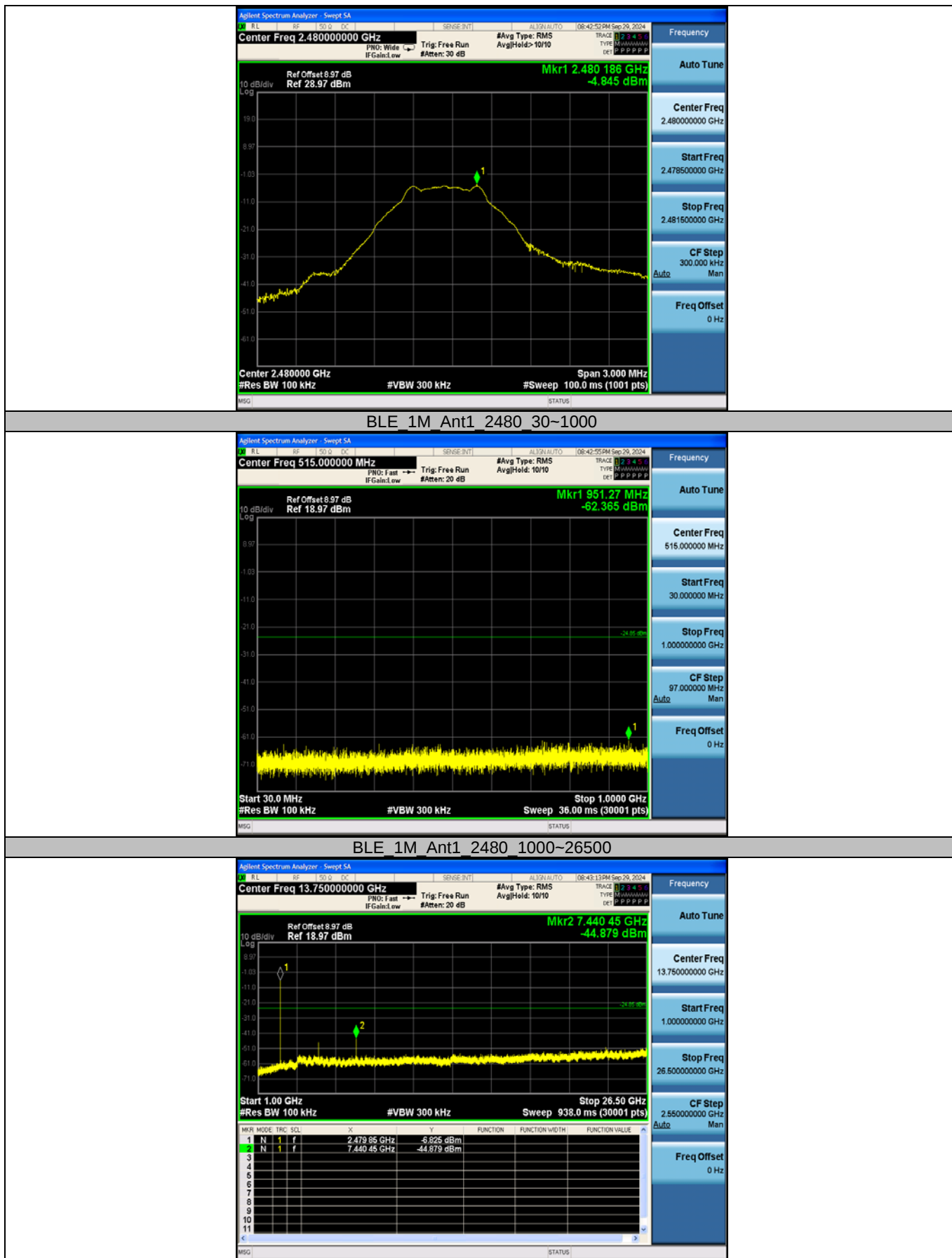
## BLE 1M Ant1 2440 30~1000

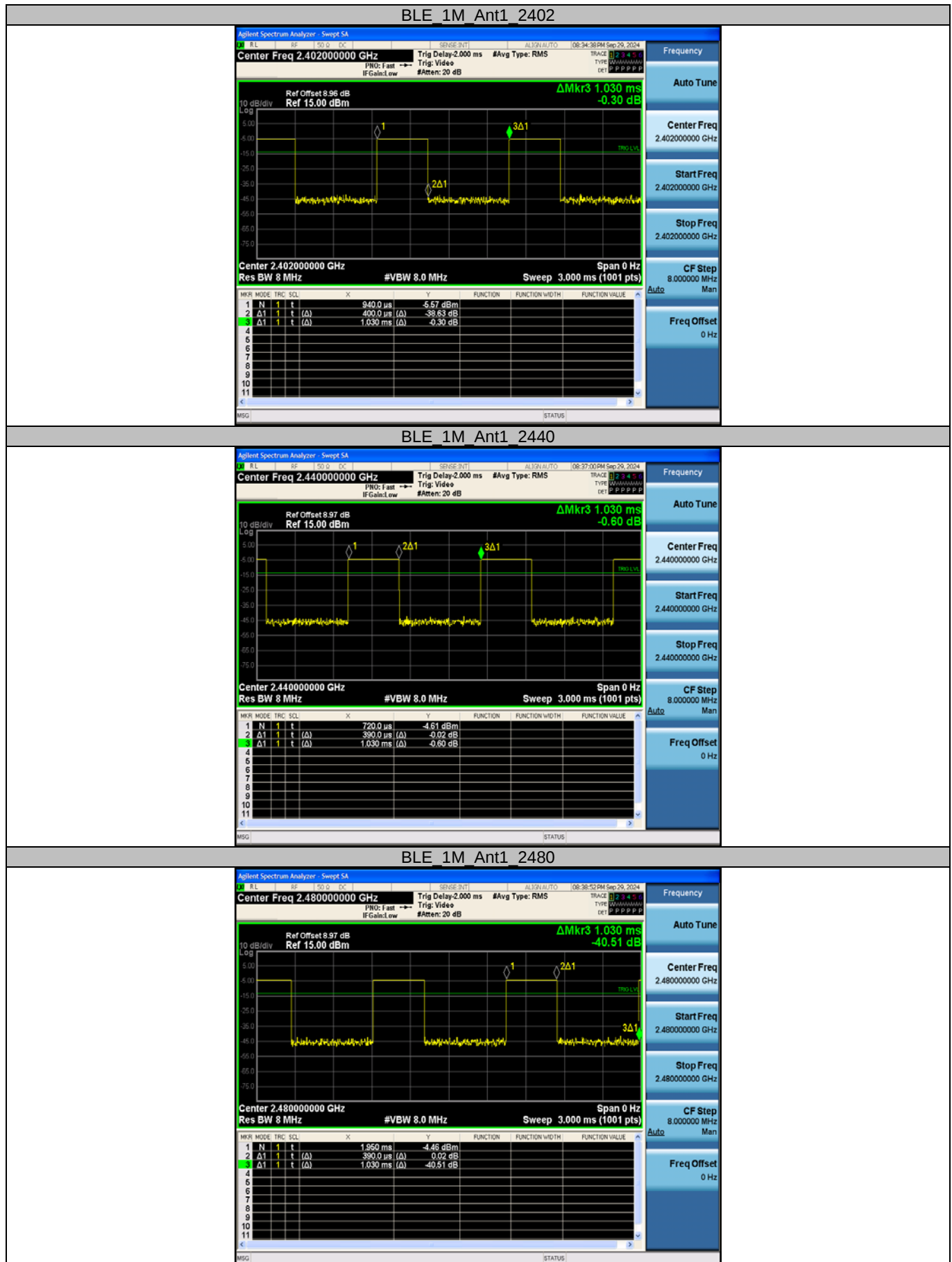
