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## For your information

### Introduction

- Use your RADIO M903AT in such a way that you have, in every traffic situation, the vehicle under complete control; for example, do not write text messages while driving, do not dock or connect the phone, do not work with the contact list, - otherwise there is a risk of an accident!
- Arrange your telephone cable in such a way that it does not interfere while driving.
- Adjust the volume so that acoustic signals from outside can always be heard (eg sirens from vehicles such as police, ambulance and fire brigade, etc.).
- If you use an excessive volume, it could cause damage to your ears!

- The instruction manual contains important information and precautions regarding the operation of this equipment.
- The product may undergo changes without prior notice, which are not included in this manual.

## favorite stations


This feature allows you to add your favorite stations to the main radio menu for quick selection. Stations can be stored in the radio's memory as follows:

## automatic search



- You can perform an automatic search of all the available stations, at the end of the search you will see a list with the stations found.
- To start the search press the "SCAN" button in the main menu, then to display the list of stations found press the "ALL STATIONS" button 
- You can store up to 28 stations in the station list.

## Bluetooth Mode - Bluetooth Considerations

### ! Important

If your mobile phone is compatible and does not appear in the device search, make sure that Bluetooth is activated and set to "visible to all devices".

Bluetooth connections typically work within a range approx. 8m Obstacles in the way can decrease the range.

To use the built-in hands-free device, you must first pair your mobile phone.

It cannot be guaranteed that all mobile phones can be paired and that they all work properly.

### ! HANDS-FREE DISCLAIMER BLUETOOTH ®

The types of Bluetooth ® devices (including mobile phones) that can be connected to the hands-free system are limited, and even among compatible devices, there are some that may not work reliably with this product.

Manufacturers of Bluetooth ® devices may incorporate certain changes, within this standard protocol, during the life cycle of your M903AT radio. These changes are out of the control of this product and may become an impediment to Bluetooth ® mode.

## Bluetooth Mode - Connection

### Connection and bonding

The range of the telephone connection to the equipment is limited to the passenger compartment.

To link a phone via Bluetooth with the radio, it is necessary to link the two devices together.

The pairing process depends on whether or not there is another phone connected to the device when pairing a new device.

### Pairing and connection process

To link a device, please make sure that the device you want to connect to the unit is turned on and has the resources to detect and search for it.

### Pairing and connection process

ÿ Press the search button.  
ÿ Your device will appear in the list. ÿ Select your device and confirm the automatically generated password.

During the pairing and connection process, indication notices are displayed on the equipment screen as well as on the phone screen. These notices should be considered and confirmed (authorizing contact import or Bluetooth player connection, etc.)

\*Up to 5 mobile devices can be stored for quick pairing.

If you have two Bluetooth devices, you can connect one for call profile and the other as bluetooth player profile, as shown in the picture "SMARTPHONE 1" is connected as Bluetooth player and "SMARTPHONE 2" is connected as phone for calls.

You can make this type of connection with any phone that is on your list of Bluetooth devices. Cannot connect two devices for calls or two devices as Bluetooth player.

## smartphone connectivity

### Use

Smartphone connectivity is via USB cable, be it Lightning for iPhone and Mini, Micro or USB C para Android.

## Android Auto - Initial Setup

### Instructions

1. Download the Android Auto app from Google Play.
2. Plug your Android phone into the USB port.
3. Accept all legal notices and authorization requests required to use Android Auto on your Android phone.
4. Press HOME and then tap the Android Auto icon. The Android Auto interface will appear full screen on your radio screen. Touch and control apps.

1. Go to: "Toyota". By using this command, it displays the online map, which can be Waze or Google maps.
2. Play: If the user has Google Music or Spotify downloaded, for example, they can point to "Play Michael Jackson" and the system will display a playlist of the selected artist.
3. Call: The user can use the command Call "Dad" for example, and it will pick up the phone registered in the contact list. They can also be places like "Call Toyota".
