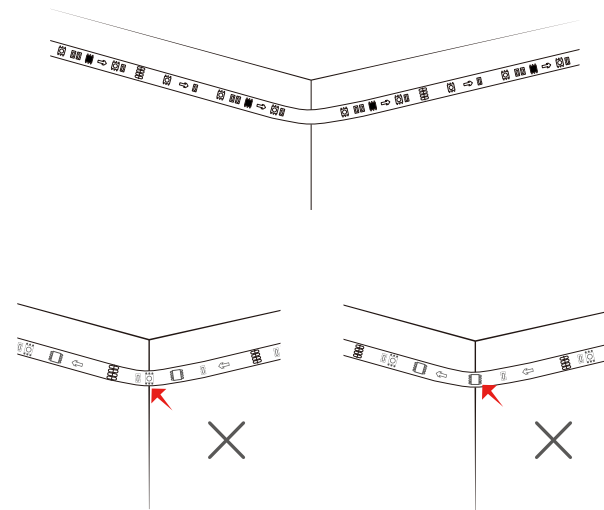


Recommended Tip: Try not to bend at electronic components like light beads, bonding pad to avoid short circuit.

Pairing Instructions

1. Download the APP and install on your phone.
2. Turn on the Bluetooth on your phone.
3. Open the APP, tap the "+" icon in the top right corner and search new device.
4. APP will show the device found, just add it.
5. Tap the device icon to enter control panel.

Tips and Cautions

1. Use the product with the provided power adapter and control box only.
2. Unroll the strip light before powering on.
3. Do power on test before installation.
4. Pull out the transparent sheet from IR remote before using.
5. Be cautious of static electricity during installation and usage.
6. Do NOT allow children to install the strip light alone.
7. Please turn off the power and unplug the adapter if the strip light will not be used for a long time.
8. Keep the product away from sharp objects or strong corrosive chemicals.
9. Please do NOT connect more strips to the product which will cause the power adapter overload.
10. Adjust mic sensitivity and the distance between sound source and phone/device mic in Music Mode to get best music sync effect.
