


3*AAA batteries for transmitter (batteries sold separately)





- a. The Transmitter uses 3*AAA non-rechargeable batteries, or AAA rechargeable batteries (sold separately).
- b. Make sure that the battery is correctly installed when installing or replacing the batteries.
- c. Non-rechargeable batteries should not be recharged. You can only use the recommended batteries or identical ones.
- d. Do not use batteries which are different types or ages.
- e. Take out drained batteries in a timely manner and dispose them as your local government demands.
- f. Please take out the batteries if it will not be used for a long period of time to avoid any damage to the product in case of battery leakage.

ICON ON APP



1. Tap the button on the right side of the back of the Transmitter, or tap the  button in the application, and the blue signal light on camera will blink once, indicating that the camera took a picture.
2. Press the left  button on the back of the Transmitter once or tap  the button in the application, the blue signal light on the camera will start to blink, indicating that the camera is now recording.
3. Hold once  or press shortly  to stop video recording, and save the video into APP and TF card (DO NOT take photo during taking video.)
